

VOODOO QP DOLL PIN CUSHION


WHAT YOU NEED:

- Scrap of fabric roughly 10"x16"
- Polyfil stuffing
- Buttons for eyes
- Eleganza Perle Cotton for hair and embellishments


WHAT TO DO

1. Fold your fabric in half widthwise, right sides together so you end up with an 8"x10" rectangle. Trace the voodoo doll template onto the fabric (a lightbox comes in handy for this but you can also cut the template out along the solid line to trace it). Pin all around the tracing to hold your folded fabric together.

"Hair" is between the two layers of fabric



2. If you want to add hair to your voodoo doll, cut some lengths of Eleganza Perle Cotton and insert the strands between the two layers at the head of the doll. Make sure that the strands will be underneath your stitch line.



3. Sew along your traced line, making sure to leave a gap under the right arm as indicated on the pattern. Tack at the beginning and end of the stitch. If you added hair, shorten your stitch length while sewing around the head.


4. Cut out your doll roughly 1/4" all around your sewn line. Snip the fabric around any curves and inside the armpits.

5. Turn right-sides out and stuff the doll with Polyfil. Use a point turner, Purple Thang, stiletto, etc to make sure you get the stuffing into all the crevices.

6. Hand stitch the opening under the arm closed. It doesn't have to be perfect, that's the beauty of a voodoo doll!

7. Hand sew a large running stitch around the doll's neck and pull the thread end to gather it in. Tie a knot and bury the thread. Hand stitch where the arms and legs attach as well, leaving it ungathered.

8. Embellish as you like with button eyes, hand embroidery, and even tiny outfits!



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
