

## **CORK Binder pouch Supply List for Class**

- These supplies are available at the store at the best price we can offer. We also help you pick the best value products for your class. We have all of these supplies at our store.

- sewing machine with cord/pedal and manual
- Rotary cutter and small mat
- Seam ripper
- Wonder clips - we cannot always pin
- Double sided By Annies tape
- Chalk marker or easily removable marker
- Vinyl/leather sewing machine needle or Jeans #14
- Thread to match Cork
- Sallie Tomato Binder Pouch Pattern
- Punch tool to make holes and mini mat
- Exacto or sharp fine craft knife
- 505 glue stick
- Small screwdriver set

**Material list:** I made several out of a roll of cork and vinyl - once you know how they are a snap to make.

- Cork **or** firm faux leather (at least 12" x 25" per pouch) - it does come in a roll of 18" x 25" OR 2 coordinating pieces 10" x 12"
- Clear vinyl - 10" x 6" or more
- Heavy stabilizer, such as craft-tex sew in, at least 12" x 2"
- Zipper by the yard and one zipper tab - 10"
- (3) screw in Sallie Tomato grommets
