

DIAMONDS ARE FOREVER Supply List for Class

We are making Lone Star Diamond blocks in class. This is the most difficult of the diamond blocks you can make with this ruler, but if you can do this, you can do any of the other variations!

- Please be prepared for class by purchasing the supplies you need **before** the class starts. We start on time to provide the best instruction possible.
- These supplies are available at the store at the best price we can offer. We also help you pick the best value products for your class.



- ☐ sewing machine with cord/pedal and manual
- ☐ sewing machine needle #10 Microtex or jeans as we need it to be sharp in the star centers
- ☐ ¼" foot for your machine - very important
- ☐ rotary cutter
- ☐ Seam ripper
- ☐ flat-head pins
- ☐ Sharp scissors for snipping thread
- ☐ Masking tape or labels
- ☐ 18" x 24" cutting mat
- ☐ Rotating rotary mat is very useful
- ☐ 12 ½" or larger square ruler
- ☐ 100% cotton thread to blend - wind up two bobbins
- ☐ Creative Grids CGRJAW15 (6in Diamond Trim Tool) - bring ruler instructions.
- ☐ Precision glue and Easy press pen is **very** useful and will be demonstrated
- ☐ Best press or easy press spray - very important to keep the bias edges more stable

FABRICS REQUIRED: (Basic Lone Star is approx. 20" square)

Use non-directional fabrics with small print or tone

Dark (black in my star) 25 cm

Light 1 (green in my star) 25 cm

Center (orange in my star) 35 cm

Light 2 (grey in my star) 25 cm

Background (peach in my block) 40 cm

Borders can be added or you can make more blocks. Inner border can be plainer but outer borders could be large print or more colourful.

HOMEWORK:

Spray and press and label each fabric.
