

Four patch Stacking quilt





Left is a sample of the type of blocks we will make

Right are the type of quilts we could make

*Choose a fabric with lots of large variations – not a small print which could be boring. Ask before we start cutting so that we get the best quilt blocks 😊

*This could be made a lot bigger if you want.

The amounts below make 76 ½” square quilt. This is just a suggestion.



Print: Four repeats (**at least 12” each repeat**) The bigger the repeat the larger the quilt.

12” repeat about 1.5 meters

18” repeat about 2 meters

24” repeat about 2.7 meters

Background and sashing: 3 meters – depending on the print you have or the size you are making

Posts and first border: 70 cm – 1.2 meter

Corners: 40 cm – 50 cm

Outside border: 1.6 meters or more

Binding: 60 cm or more

NOTIONS:

Best Press

6 ½” x 24” ruler or larger

14 ½” square ruler or larger

If you have an XL Stripology ruler you could use this and do things very quickly

GE repositionable arrows, these really help with trimming

Flat head flower pins – must be this type of pin

Folded Corner Clipper ruler or Goddess tool

Marking pencil to show on the fabrics

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade, we are cutting multiple layers

Mat 18" x 24" – not smaller

Wonder clips

Sewing machine with ¼" foot, pedal, plug in and manual

Inside shoes

Snack (NO onions or garlic as we have someone here with severe allergies) NO perfumes please
