

String Quilt Supply List for Class

We are making a scrappy String Quilt block. Everyone will be working on a different size project, so our fabric amounts will vary. You can vary the scraps you use, but use the ideas given to make your quilt "zing".

*Mask required

- To help our busy students, the store is open until 5:00pm to purchase supplies.
- Please be prepared for class by purchasing the supplies you need before the class starts. We start on time to provide the best instruction possible.
- These supplies are available at the store at the best price we can offer. We also help you pick the best value products for your class.

- sewing machine with cord/pedal and manual
- sewing machine needle #10 Microtex or jeans as we need it to be sharp
- ¼" foot for your machine
- rotary cutter
- Seam ripper
- flat-head pins
- Sharp scissors for snipping thread
- Masking tape or labels
- 18" x 24" cutting mat
- 6" x 24" or larger long ruler
- 6 ½" or larger square ruler
- Quick trim ruler is useful
- Stripology ruler is really useful for all those strips
- Best press
- Micron pen
- 100% cotton thread to blend - wind up two bobbins

Sample #1: White zinger and same colour family in each block

Sample #2: Purple zinger, half block in greens and half block in creams

FABRICS:

We are sewing to SCRAP TAPE - this comes in a 13" roll and is 10yds long, so you get over 110 blocks. If you want to make a small runner and try the technique, use 1 meter of Soft & Sheer.

- Scrape tape roll or Soft & Sheer
- Light or dark fabrics that all blend together - this is for the "plain" side
- Contrasting but matching fabrics that look good together - these should look very different from the Light or Dark fabrics you have chosen
- One or two 'zinger' or accents that is very different from all the other, and they should be more of a tone on tone or solid

What works? Honey buns, jelly roll strips, fat 1/8's or fat quarters or scraps. Your 'zinger' should be enough for the project.

Zinger = Runner: 10 cm Throw: 1 meter
