Class Supplies: Strippy Stars

MASKS ARE REQUIRED IN STORE

- To help our busy students, the store is open until 5:00pm to purchase supplies.
- Please be ready for your class as we have to start on time to accomplish all that we need to do.
- These supplies are available at the store at the best price we can offer.
 - Sewing machine, manual and cords
 - Sewing machine needles jeans #10
 - Flat-head pins
 - Rotary cutter
 - Seam ripper
 - 1/4" foot for your machine
 - Thread snips and sharp fabric scissors
 - 18" x 24" mat
 - Strippy Stars tool by Creative Grids
 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " ruler is very useful square or rectangle if you do not have You will need 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or larger square ruler
 - 6" x 24" or larger ruler
 - Labels or masking tape
 - wonder clips are useful

We are making large and small star blocks that never "lose" their points and we do not have to cut out any triangles to make them. Quilt is $59 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or you can make it smaller with no borders.

You can make this in many different ways:

<u>Star points</u> from Jelly roll 2 ½" strips, make them scrappy – or from yardage of one or two colours. <u>Star centers</u> from 5" charm squares or make them all the same <u>Background</u> from yardage

FABRICS:

 Star points: (20) 2 ½" jelly roll strips OR 1.1 meter of one fabric OR .55 of two fabrics (Red and cream shown)

 Star Centers: 25cm of one fabric, or (14) 5" charm squares, as shown or (4) 10" layer cake squares

 Background: 2m of one fabric

 Inner border: .45

 Outer border: 1.4m

 Binding: .6

 Backing: 3.2m

 Batting: 1.6m

- Cotton thread to blend with background fabric

Homework:

- wind up two bobbins
- Cut Background across the width of fabric (Selvedge to selvedge)
 - Two 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Two 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Nine 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Two 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- Cut **Star point** yardage across the width of fabric (Selvedge to selvedge) into a total of (12) 2 ¹/₂" strips (if using two colours do six of each colour) and bring the rest to class. If you have jelly roll strips, bring them to class.
- DO NOT CUT THE REST OF THE FABRIC AND BRING ALL TO CLASS
