- ❖ Best Press spray is your friend, as these blocks are cut with odd shapes. Best Press your fabrics and have them ready and we will accomplish a lot in class.

SUPPLIES:

- ☐ Sewing machine with 1/4" foot and manual/foot pedal and cords
- □ Rotary cutter
- □ Rotating mat 12" or larger is extremely useful for block trimming and cutting. As we are using pre-cut jelly rolls a large mat should not be necessary. If you do not have a rotating mat, bring a mat 16" or larger.
- ☐ Best press spray
- ☐ Pins
- ☐ Seam ripper
- Thread snips
- ☐ Wonky Log Cabin ruler by Creative Grids
- ☐ Quick Trim ruler
- □ 6" x 24 1/2" or larger long ruler
- Wonder clips
- ☐ GE organising labels are wonderful as they have sizes that you can put on your wonder clips if you do not have these, bring post-it notes

FABRICS:

Amounts given will make 52" x 72" throw with borders.

- \square 1 print or dark jelly roll (40 2 ½" strips)
- 1 solid or background jelly roll (40 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips) *OR* 1.75m of background. Best press this and cut it into (40) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- □ 50 cm dark center fabric which will also be the inner border.
- 2 meters outer border/binding you do not need to bring this to class, but you will need it to finish the project.
