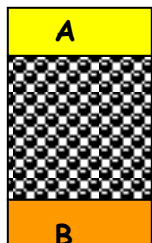


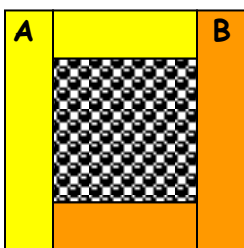
1. Line up your suspects: Make a CSI sheet of your clues and suspects by cutting a small scrap of each and labeling them. **do an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and pay careful attention to lining up the suspects in the correct order with fabric placement on the correct side.*

CLUE 1

Gather the 12 $4\frac{1}{2}$ " feature fabric squares, and suspect A and B $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew A to the TOP of each square and B to the BOTTOM of each square. Press to A and B.



Now sew an A $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " to each LEFT SIDE and a B to each RIGHT SIDE. Press to A and B.

CLUE 2

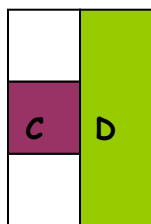
Gather 18 background $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, nine $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangles, 9 C squares and 9 D $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Sew two background squares to each side of C. Press in one direction. Make 9

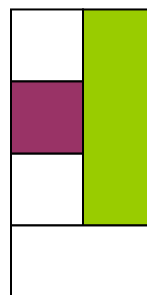


Sew a D $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the right side of the above strip. Press to D.



CLUE 2 continued

Sew a background $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the bottom of the above background. You should have 9. This is UNIT 1
