# FABRICS AND SUPPLIES: Project #1 - EASY BEGINNER

Makes 60" square quilt top (Blocks can be rotated in different ways) 250m or more cotton thread to blend - wind up two bobbins 1 Print Jelly Roll (40 strips)

2.2m background that will contrast well with the print Jelly Roll

- cut (72) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares if you have the time at home.

\*4 in 1 half square ruler

# FABRICS AND SUPPLIES: Project #2 - CONFIDENT QUILTER Makes 72" square quilt top

250m or more cotton thread to blend - wind up two bobbins

1 Print Jelly Roll (40 strips)

1 Solid Jelly Roll and 50 cm of the same or very similar background - this must contrast

**OR** 3.2m of solid or tone on tone background - Cut into 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips if you have the time at home.

\*12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler
