### **Checklist - Preparing your Quilt for Machine Quilting**

- Check all seams - repair any open seams.
- Press quilt top, first from the back - flatten all the seams. And then press from the front. I like to use Best Press or Magic Sizing when pressing - gives the quilt a nice, crisp finish - and it smells good too!
- Trim all loose threads.
- Stay stitch around the quilt where there are any seams. This prevents the seams from coming apart while your quilt is being quilted.
- Fold quilt and backing or hang on a hanger.
- Backing should be 8" wider and 10" longer than your quilt.
- Batting should also be 8" wider and 10 inches longer than your quilt. You can purchase Quilters Dream Batting from me or bring your favorite batting.
