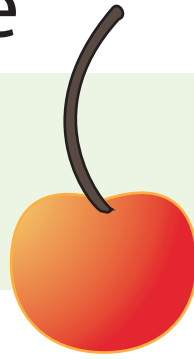


Cheat at Appliqué

Kit \$10 (pay in class):

Pattern with a choice of applique shapes.

Notion Kit

You are welcome to bring your own pattern if it has at least 10 shapes to appliqué.

Supplies for Templates:

Scissors for paper and scissors for fabric

Washable school glue stick

Glue Baste-it or Appli Glue

Scotch Tape

Mechanical Pencil

Supplies for Appliqué:

Sewing machine and thread to match fabrics

Hand sewing kit with a variety of needles, threader and thimble

Iron, pressing sheet and ironing pad

Extension cord and light

Polyester "invisible" monofilament thread

One 6" square of each:

Steam-a-Seam 2 lite or Soft Fuse

Misty fuse

Fabric: May be scrappy or a selection of your favorite colors.

Fabrics for your own pattern or:

12 squares of background fabric 8"x 8".

12 squares at least 6". These do not need to be cut.

Two 4"x12" strips for clam shells
