- $1 / 4 y d$ - Pup Patch (19135-MLT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 4$ yd - Painted Paws (19137-WHT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 4$ yd - Graffiti Love (19140-BLK-CTN-D)
- $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ - Caps and Cans (19141-MLT-CTN-D)
- $33 / 4$ yds - Caps and Cans (19141-MLT-CTN-D) for Backing


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 66 in x 74 in ( $167.64 \mathrm{~cm} \times 187.96 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.

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## Solid White - $3 / 4$ yd $x$ oof ( $68.58 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

Caps and Cans - 19141-MLT-CTN-D $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd} \times$ wof ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $4-4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

1. Refer to Diagram A to sew one White Solid strip 3 in $\times 41 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 105.41 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to each side of the Large Panel $341 / 2$ in x $41 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $87.63 \mathrm{~cm} \times 105.41 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew one White Solid strip 3 in x $391 / 2 \mathrm{in}(7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 100.33 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to the top and bottom of the Large Panel. Trim the unit to measure $371 / 2$ in $\times 45 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(95.25 \mathrm{~cm} \times 115.57 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make the Unit 1 rectangle.


Trim to measure $371 / 2$ in $\times 451 / 2$ in $(95.25 \mathrm{~cm} \times 115.57 \mathrm{~cm})$ after the borders are added.
2. Refer to Diagram B for fabric placement to sew RST ten white solid strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 41 / 2 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Bright Squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one Pup Patch $31 / 2$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in ( $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), two Painted Paws squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Graffiti Love Squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two Caps and Cans squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make the Left Side Pieced Border which should measure $41 / 2$ in $\times 45 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 115.57 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
3. Refer to Diagram C for fabric placement to sew RST ten white solid strips $11 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Bright Squares $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one Pup Patch $31 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), two Painted Paws squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Graffiti Love Squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two Caps and Cans squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make the Right Side Pieced Border which should measure $41 / 2$ in $\times 45 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 115.57 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

4. Refer to Diagram D for fabric placement to sew RST eight white solid strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 41 / 2 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Bright Squares $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one Pup Patch $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Pup Patch squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Painted Paws squares $4^{1 / 2}$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two Graffiti Love Squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make Top Pieced Border which should measure $41 / 2$ in $\times 451 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 115.57 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

5. Refer to Diagram E for fabric placement to sew RST eight white solid strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), two Bright Squares $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one Pup Patch $41 / 2$ in $\times 51 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), two Pup Patch squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Painted Paws squares $4^{1 / 2}$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two Graffiti Love Squares $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make Bottom Pieced Border which should measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 45 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 115.57 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

6. Refer to Diagram F to sew the Left Side Pieced Border and Right Side Pieced Border to the left and to the right of Unit 1. Sew the Top Pieced Border and Bottom Pieced Border to the top and to the bottom of Unit 1to make Unit 2. The Unit should measure $451 / 2$ in $\times 53^{1 / 2}$ in ( $115.57 \mathrm{~cm} \times 135.89 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

7. Sew three White Solid strips 1 in $\times 42$ in $(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ). From the sewn strip cut two White Solid strips 1 in $\times 531 / 2 \mathrm{in}(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 135.89 \mathrm{~cm})$. Refer to Diagram $G$ to sew one White Solid strip 1 in $\times 531 / 2 \mathrm{in}(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 135.89 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to each side of Unit 2.

8. Sew three White Solid strips 1 in $\times 42$ in $(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip cut two White Solid strips 1 in $\times 461 / 2$ in ( $2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 118.11 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Refer to Diagram G to sew one White Solid strip 1 in $\times 46 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 118.11 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to the top and to the bottom of Unit 2 to make the Quilt Center. The Quilt Center should measure $461 / 2$ in $\times 541 / 2$ in $(118.11 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm})$.
9. Sew two Wall to Wall strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip cut one Wall to Wall strip $21 / 2$ in $\times 62$ in $(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 135.89 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make one Inner Side Border. Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.
10. Sew three Wall to Wall strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip cut two Wall to Wall strips $21 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 54 \mathrm{in}(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 137.16 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make one Top Inner Border and one Bottom Inner Border.
11. Center one Inner Side Border $21 / 2$ in $\times 62$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 157.48 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on one side of the Quilt Center RST and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) from the top edge of the unit and stop $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) away from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
12. Repeat Step 11 to sew Inner Top Border $21 / 2$ in $\times 54$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 137.16 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and Inner Bottom Border $21 / 2$ in $\times 54$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 137.16 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) away from each end of the block.
13. To miter each corner, fold the Quilt Center on a diagonal with RST and edges matching. This should line up the Borders from adjacent sides as shown in Diagram H. Starting at the sewn seam as shown by the arrow in Diagram H, draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the Border. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to miter the Inner Border as shown in Diagram I; press. The Quilt Center should measure $501 / 2$ in x $581 / 2$ in ( $128.27 \mathrm{~cm} \times 148.59 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

14. Sew two Urban Cityscape strips $41 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip cut one Urban Cityscape strip $41 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 70$ in ( $2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 135.89 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make one Outer Side Border. Repeat to make a second Outer Side Border.
15. Sew three Urban Cityscape strips $41 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip cut two Urban Cityscape strips $41 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 62 \mathrm{in}(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 157.48 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make the Top Border and the Bottom Border.
16. Center one Urban Cityscape Outer Side Border $41 / 2$ in $x 70$ in ( $2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 135.89 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on one side of the Quilt Center RST and pin in place. Start sewing the strip $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) from the top edge of the Quilt Center and stop $1 / 4 \mathrm{in}(\mathbf{6 . 3 5} \mathbf{~ m m}$ ) from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
17. Repeat Step 16 to sew the Urban Cityscape strip $41 / 2$ in $x 62$ in $(2.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 157.48 \mathrm{~cm})$ to the top and the Urban Cityscape to the bottom of the Quilt Center, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) away from each end of the Quilt Center, RST.
18. Refer to Diagram H to miter each of the four corners of the Outer Border and complete the Quilt Top as shown in Diagram J; press. The completed Quilt Top should measure $581 / 2$ in $\times 661 / 2$ in $(148.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 168.91 \mathrm{~cm})$.

19. To make the Caps and Cans Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42 in $x 66$ in ( $106.68 \mathrm{~cm} \times 167.64 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check the orientation of the design. Pin and sew the strips RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram K. Trim the Back to measure 66 in x 74 in ( $167.64 \mathrm{~cm} \times 187.96 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).


Trim to measure 66 in $\times 74$ in ( $167.64 \mathrm{~cm} \times 187.96 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
20. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing fabric. Tape the Backing wrong side up on a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
21. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
22. To make the Bright Squares Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the seven $21 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in ( 5.08 cm ) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. L). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
