Table Runner: 16 ½" x 64 ½" (41.91cm x 163.38cm)

3 Wishes Fabric® Rustic Roosters Collection

Placemats (4)

- 1 Panel – 13849-Multi (Rooster Panel)
- 7/8 yd (80.01cm) – 13850-Tan (Words) for backing

Table Runner

- 1 1/8 yds (102.87cm) – 13850-Tan (Words) for pieces and backing
- 7/8 yd (80.01cm) – 13851-Burgundy (Burgundy Leaves) for pieces and binding
- 1/2 yd (45.72cm) – 13854-Cream (Roosters)
- 1/4 yd (22.80cm) – 13852-Tan (Tan Leaves)
- 1/4 yd (22.80cm) – 13853-Multi (Map)

Additional Supplies Needed

- Cotton Batting – 28" x 36" (71.12cm x 91.44cm) for Placemats and 18" x 66" (45.72cm x 167.64cm) for Table Runner
- Coordinating thread
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies

Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼" (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

Placemats

Cutting

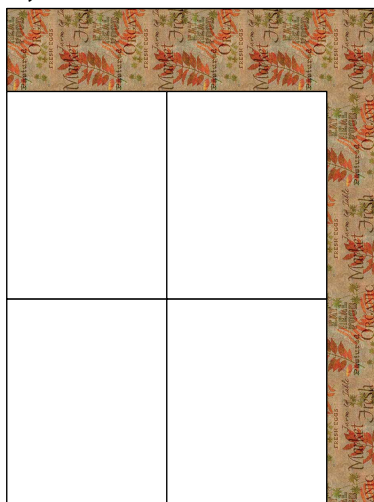
1. Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.

Rooster Panel (13849-Multi)
1 yd (91.44cm x 106.68cm)



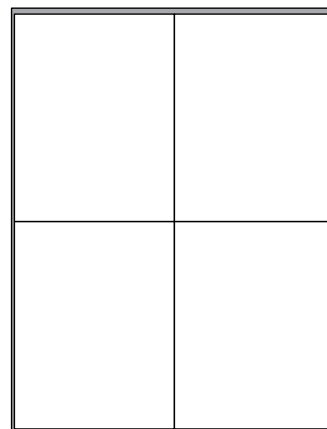
Cut out the four placemat fronts along the burgundy edge.

Words (13850-Tan)
7/8 yd (80.01cm x 106.68cm)



Cut four placemat backs the same size as the placemat fronts. *Note direction of fabric design.

28" x 36" (71.12cm x 91.44cm)

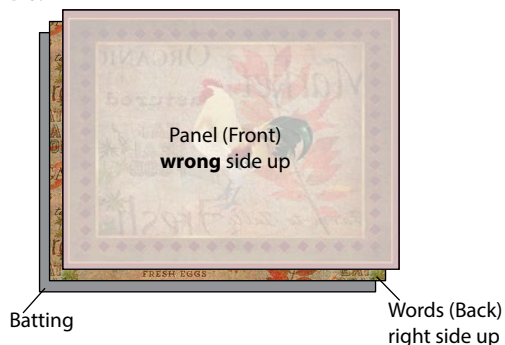


Cut four batting pieces the same size as the placemat fronts.

Piecing

2. Place a Rooster Panel (Front) and a Words/13850-Tan (Back) (13 ½" x 17 ½", 34.29cm x 44.45cm) RST on top of the batting. Match the edges and pin layers together every 2"-3" (5.08cm - 7.62cm) as shown in Diagram A.

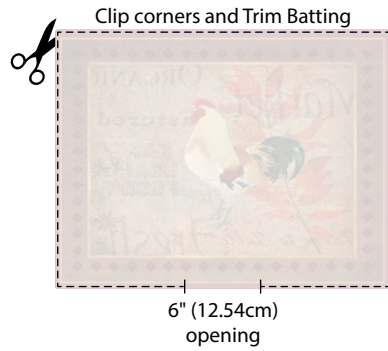

Match the edges and pin layers together every 2"-3" (5.08cm - 7.62cm)

3. Sew around the edges leaving a 6" (15.24cm) opening at the bottom for turning. Carefully clip corners and trim batting close to the seam to reduce bulk. Turn right side out. Slip stitch the opening closed. Press flat. Repeat to make four Placemats 13" x 17" (33.02cm x 43.18cm).

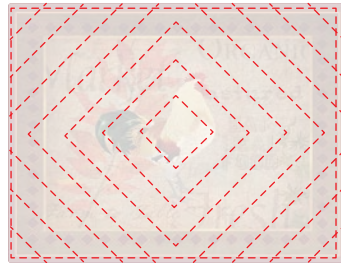

4. Topstitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6.35mm) around the edge. Quilt a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " (6.99cm) diamond in the center, then diagonal lines 2" (5.08cm) apart to the outside corners (Dia. C) or quilt overall hexagons measuring 2" (5.08cm) on the sides (template provided) to look like chicken wire (Dia. D).

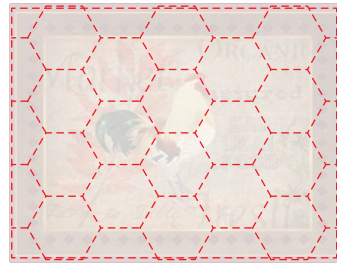


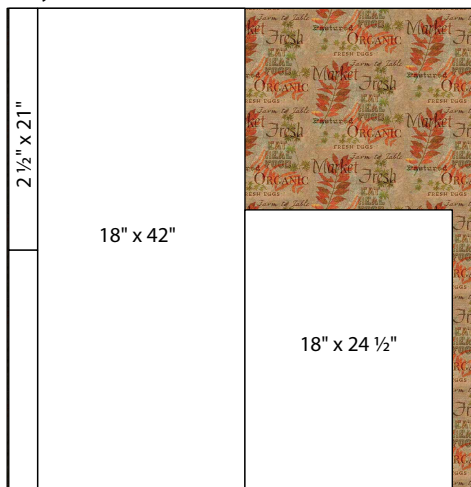
Table Runner

Cutting

1. Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.

Words (13850-Tan)

Cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 21" (6.35cm x 53.34cm)

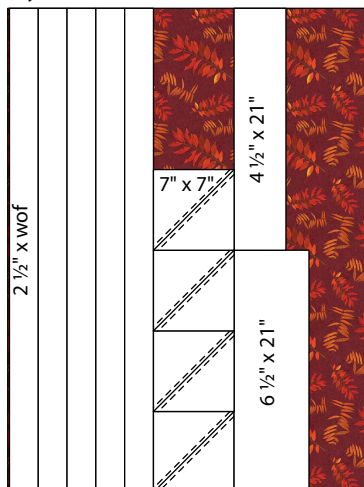
Cut 1 - 18" x 42" (45.72cm x 106.68cm) for Backing

Cut 1 - 18" x 24 1/2" (45.72cm x 62.63cm) for Backing

*Note direction of fabric design.

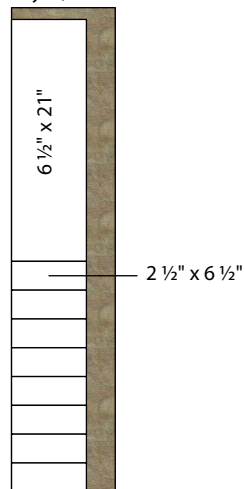

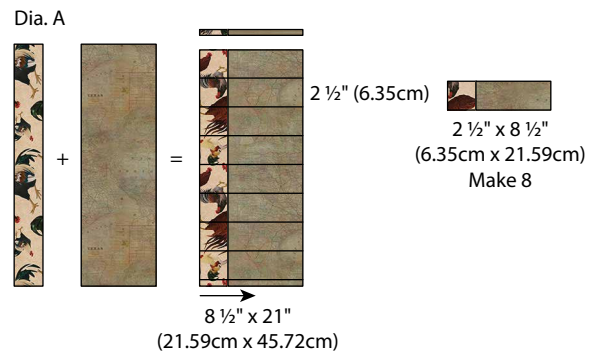

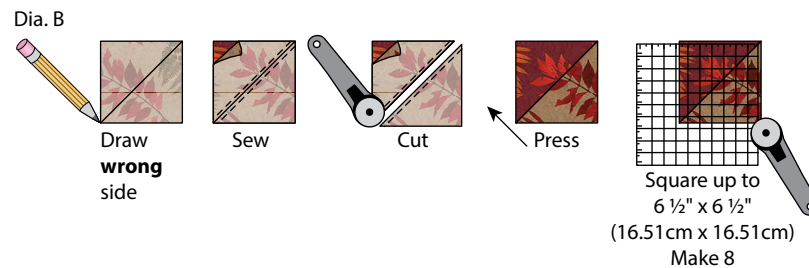
Cut 8 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" (6.35cm x 16.51cm)

Piecing

- Position the Roosters (13854-Cream) strip (2 1/2" x 21", 6.35cm x 53.34cm) with the Map (13853-Multi) strip (6 1/2" x 21", 16.51cm x 53.34cm). Pin RST and sew on the long sides; press. The strip set should measure 8 1/2" (21.59cm) wide. Straighten one end and cut into 2 1/2" (6.35cm) units to make a total of eight 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" (6.35cm x 21.59cm) Roosters/Map Strip Units (Dia. A).

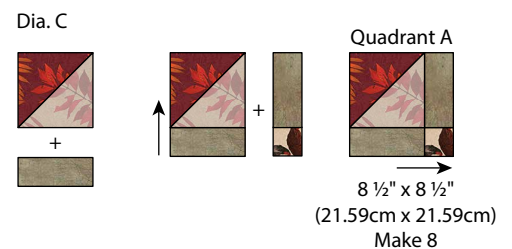


- Draw a diagonal line on the **wrong** side of the Tan Leaves (13852-Tan) squares (7" x 7", 17.78cm x 17.78cm). Place a Tan Leaves square on top of a Burgundy Leaves (13851-Burgundy) square (7" x 7", 17.78cm x 17.78cm) with RST and sew 1/4" (6.35mm) away from the line on both sides. Cut on the drawn line; press. **Note:** Two squares yield two Half-Square Triangle (HST) Units, 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (16.51cm x 16.51), trim if necessary. Repeat to make a total of eight HST Units (Dia. B).

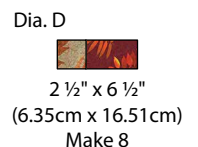


- Position a Map (13853-Multi) rectangle (2 1/2" x 6 1/2", 6.35cm x 16.51cm) and a HST Unit made in Step 3 as shown. Pin RST, sew, and press.

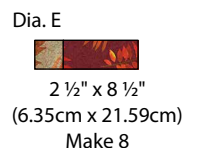
Position a Rooster/Map Strip Unit, made in Step 2, as shown. Pin, sew, and press, matching seams, to make Quadrant A measuring 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" (21.59cm x 21.59cm) as shown in Diagram C. Repeat to make eight.



- Follow Step 2 and use a Words (13850-Tan) strip (2 1/2" x 21", 6.35cm x 53.34cm) with the Burgundy Leaves (13851-Burgundy) strip (4 1/2" x 21", 11.43cm x 53.34cm) to make a total of eight 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" (6.35cm x 16.51cm) Words/Burgundy Leaves Strip Units (Dia. D).

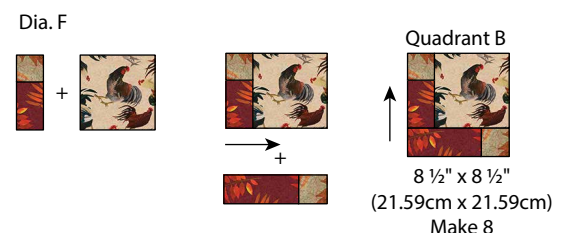


- Follow Step 2 and use a Words (13850-Tan) strip (2 1/2" x 21", 6.35cm x 53.34cm) with the Burgundy Leaves (13851-Burgundy) strip (6 1/2" x 21", 16.51cm x 53.34cm) to make a total of eight 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" (6.35cm x 21.59cm) Words/Burgundy Leaves Strip Units (Dia. E).

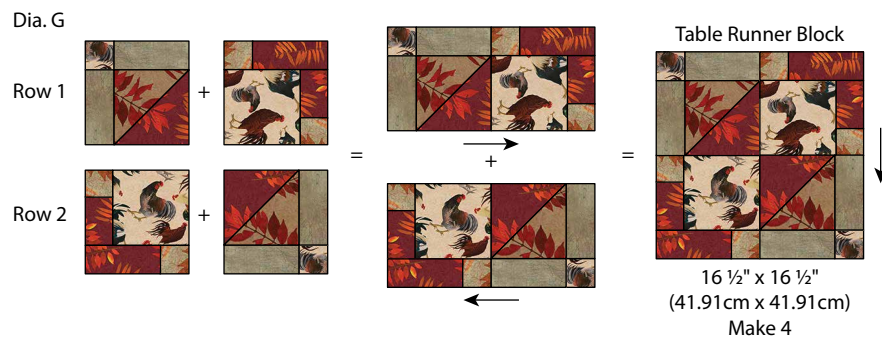


- Position a Words/Burgundy Leaves Strip Unit (2 1/2" x 6 1/2", 6.35cm x 16.51cm), made in Step 5, and a Roosters (13854-Cream) square (6 1/2" x 6 1/2", 16.51cm x 16.51cm) as shown. Pin RST, sew, and press.

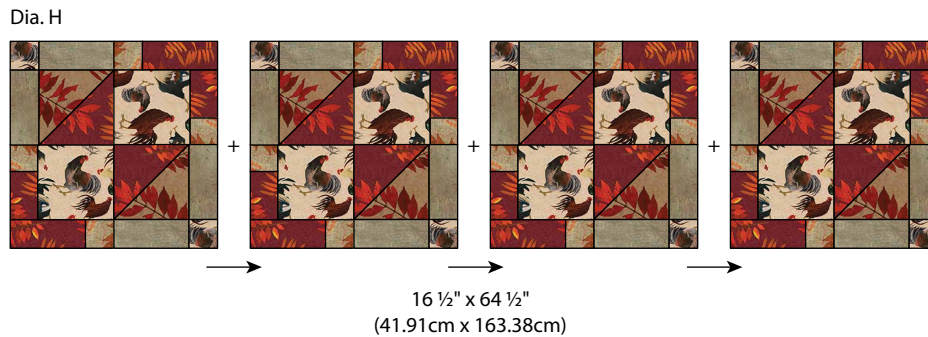
Position a Words/Burgundy Strip Unit (2 1/2" x 8 1/2", 6.35cm x 21.59cm), made in Step 6, as shown in Diagram F. Pin, sew, and press, matching seams, to make Quadrant B measuring 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" (21.59cm x 21.59cm). Repeat to make eight.



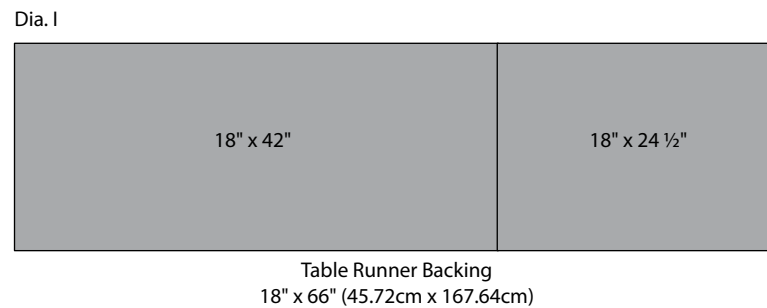
8. Position two of Quadrant A and B in two rows as shown. Pin RST, sew, and press the quadrants in each row. Pin and sew the rows together, matching the seams; press. Repeat to make four Table Runner Blocks measuring 16 1/2" x 16 1/2" (41.91cm x 41.91cm).



9. Position the four Table Runner Blocks as shown in Diagram H, pin RST, sew and press. The Table Runner should measure 16 1/2" x 64 1/2" (41.91cm x 163.38cm).

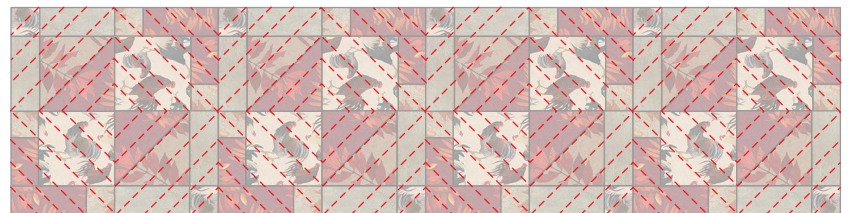


10. Pin and sew the two Words/13850-Tan backing pieces RST on the short edges, to make a Backing 18" x 66" (45.72cm x 167.64cm) as shown in Diagram I.

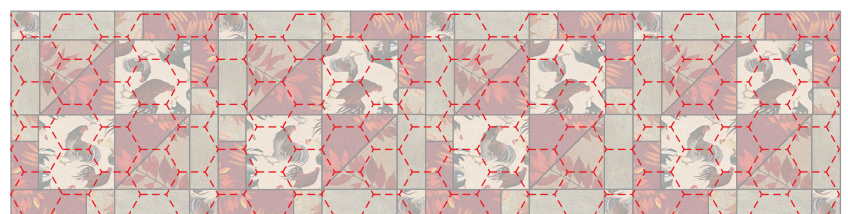


11. Press finished Table Runner and backing. Tape the backing **wrong** side up to a firm surface. Layer batting and Table Runner top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Refer to quilting Diagram J for a simple, yet creative quilting design. Quilt a 2 3/4" (6.99cm) diamond in the center of each block, then diagonal lines 2" (5.08cm) apart to the outside corners of each block. For a more challenging quilting design, refer to Table Runner Diagram K to quilt overall hexagons measuring 2" (5.08cm) on the sides (template provided) to look like chicken wire. Use masking tape or a removable marker to create a continuous straight line. **Tip:** Sewing with an even-feed foot is helpful when quilting through layers. This feeds the fabric more evenly and prevents wrinkles on the back of the Table Runner.

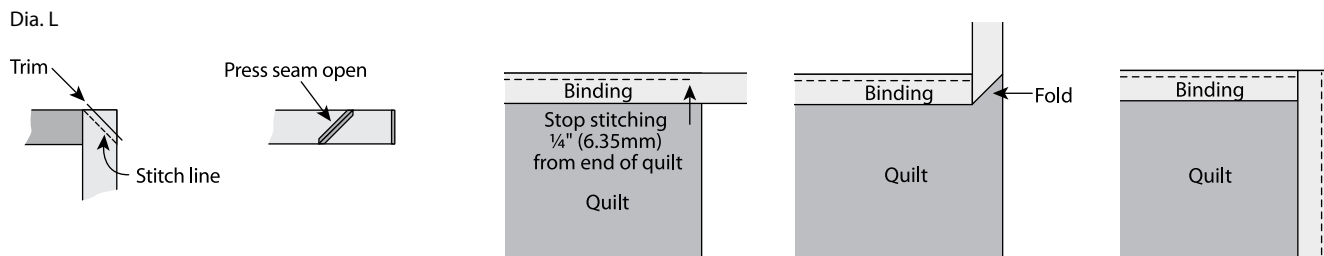

12. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess backing and batting even with the Table Runner top.
13. Refer to Diagram L to make the Burgundy Leaves/13851-Burgundy binding, remove selvages and sew the short ends of the 2 1/2" x 42" (6.35cm x 106.68cm) strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end 1/4" (6.35mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2" (5.08cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded binding even with the edge of the Table Runner top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the binding. Fold binding over to back and hand stitch.



Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using Shout® Color Catcher®. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
