- 3/8 yd (34.29cm) Texture (15854-PNK-CTN-D)
- 1/3 yd (30.48cm) Stars (15852-TRQ-CTN-D)
- 1 % yds (148.59cm) Stars (15852-TRQ-CTN-D) for Backing


- 48" x 57" (121.97cm x 144.78cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a 1/4" (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.





Sewing


1. Refer to Diagram A to make the Flying Geese Units. Draw a diagonal line on the **wrong** side of a White Lily square (2 ½" x 2 ½" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm). Place RST on the left side of a Stars rectangle (2 ½" x 4 ½" / 6.35cm x 11.43cm). Sew on the diagonal line. Trim seam to ¼" (6.35mm); press open. Repeat with a second White Lily square (2 ½" x 2 ½" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm) on the right side of the rectangle. Make 20 Flying Geese Units (2 ½" x 4 ½" / 6.35cm x 11.43cm).




2. Place two White Lily squares (2 ½" x 2 ½" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm) on each side of a Flying Geese Unit as shown in Diagram B. Pin RST and sew; press to make a Small Flying Geese Unit (2 ½" x 8 ½" / 6.35cm x 21.59cm). Make 20.




3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 and follow Diagram C, using two White Lily squares (3 ½" x 3 ½" / 8.89cm x 8.89cm), one Raindrops rectangle (3 ½" x 6 ½" / 8.89cm x 16.51cm) and two White Lily rectangles (1 ½" x 3 ½" / 3.81cm x 8.89cm) to make a Large Flying Geese Unit (3 ½" x 8 ½" / 8.89cm x 21.59cm). Make 20.



4. Place one Small Flying Geese Unit (2 ½" x 8 ½" / 6.35cm x 21.59cm) and one Large Flying Geese Unit (3 ½" x 8 ½" / 8.89cm x 21.59cm) as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST and sew; press. The Combined Flying Geese Unit should measure 5 ½" x 8 ½" (13.97cm x 21.59cm). Make 20. **Note:** Keep sharp triangle points by pinning and sewing just above the "X" intersection.



5. Refer to Diagram E to make Snowball Units. Draw a diagonal line on the **wrong** side of one Texture square (2 ½" x 2 ½" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm). Place on the corner of a Unicorn Clouds square (8 ½" x 8 ½" / 21.59cm x 21.59cm). Sew on the drawn line. Cut off the corner, leaving a ¼" (6.35mm) seam allowance; press open. Repeat for the other three corners to make one Unicorn Clouds Snowball Unit (8 ½" x 8 ½" / 21.59cm x 21.59cm). Make 9.



6. Repeat Step 5 and follow Diagram F using four Texture squares (2 ½" x 2 ½" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm) and one Prancing Unicorns square (8 ½" x 8 ½" / 21.59cm x 21.59cm) to make one Prancing Unicorns Snowball Unit (8 ½" x 8 ½" / 21.59cm x 21.59cm). Make 6.





7. Place four Combination Flying Geese Units (5 ½" x 8 ½" / 13.97cm x 21.59cm) and three Unicorn Clouds Snowball Units (8 ½" x 8 ½" / 21.59cm x 21.59cm) as shown in Diagram G. Pin RST and sew; press to make Column 1 (8 ½" x 49 ½" / 21.59cm x 125.73cm). Repeat to make Columns 3 and 5.




8. Place one Unicorn Clouds rectangle (5 ½" x 8 ½" / 13.97cm x 21.59cm), four Combination Flying Geese Units (5 ½" x 8 ½" / 13.97cm x 21.59cm) and three Prancing Unicorns Snowball Units (8 ½" x 8 ½" / 21.59cm x 21.59cm) as shown in Diagram H. Pin RST and sew; press to make Column 2 (8 ½" x 49 ½" / 21.59cm x 125.73cm). Repeat to make Column 4.




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9. Alternate Columns 1, 3 and 5 with Columns 2 and 4 (8 ½" x 49 ½" / 21.59cm x 125.73cm) as shown in Diagram I. Pin RST, matching seams and sew; press. The finished Quilt Top should measure 40 ½" x 49 ½" (102.87cm x 125.73cm).



- 10. The Stars Backing (1 % yds / 148.59cm) is enough to cover the length and width of the top. If using a long arm machine to quilt, extra fabric basted onto backing edges might be necessary.
- 11. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing **wrong** side up to a firm surface. Layer batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- 12. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess backing and batting even with the Quilt Top.
- 13. To make the Prancing Unicorns Binding, remove selvages and sew the short ends of the five 2 ½" x wof (6.35cm x 106.68cm) strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼" (6.35mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2" (5.08cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.



Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. *Tip:* Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
