

Project Instructions





Supplies Needed

- 2 1 yd. coordinating fabrics (36" x 42")
- ¼ yd. Fusible web
- ½ yd. Fusible fleece
- 2" Hook & loop tape
- Coordinating thread
- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter, mat, and acrylic ruler
- Water soluble fabric marker
- Basic sewing supplies

Before you begin: Read instructions completely before starting project. Use 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted. Instructions are for two of each item.

Cutting

Fabric A: 2 - 16" x 21" (placemats); 2 - 19" x 19" (napkins); 2 - 2 ½" x 6 ½" (napkin rings); 2 - 3 ½" x 3 ½" (small leaf)


Fabric B: 2 - 16" x 21" (placemats); 2 - 19" x 19" (napkins); 2 - 3 ½" x 3 ½" (small leaf)

Fusible Web: 2 - 3 ½" x 3 ½" (small leaf) Fusible Fleece: 2 - 16" x 21" (placemats) Hook & Loop Tape: 2 - 1" pieces

16" x 21" 16" x 21" **Cutting Chart:** Fabrics A & B 19" x 19" | 19" x 19" --**├**─3 ½" x 3 ½" 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric A only

Placemat

- 1. Layer the 16" x 21" pieces as follows: Fabric A wrong side up, fusible fleece with adhesive side down, and Fabric B right side up.
- 2. Print pages 3-6, trim and tape matching dotted edges to make a full size template. Pin template to fabric and and cut out leaf shape by cutting through all three layers (Dia. A).

Care instructions: Machine wash gentle cycle in cold water. Tumble dry on low or hang dry.


- 3. Remove pins and paper template keeping the layers together as cut. Pin the three layers down the center of the leaf, keeping layers aligned. Separate the fabric and fusible fleece layers around the outer edges only and trim the fusible fleece ³/₈" from all edges, including the stem (Dia. B).
- 4. Smooth fabric layers in place and fuse together following manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Using the leaf template as your guide, mark vein lines on Fabric B with water soluble marker. Topstitch along vein lines beginning with the center vein and working toward the outer portion of the leaf and back to the center again making a double row of stitching lines (Dia. C). Topstitch ¼" from outer edges. Repeat a second row of topstitching. Remove vein line markings.
- 6. Repeat steps 1-6 to make second placemat.




- 1. Place the 19" x 19" Fabrics A and B right sides together, pin, and sew around edges leaving a 5" opening at the center of one side. Clip corners diagonally. Turn right side out through opening; press.
- 2. Topstitch around all four sides 1/8" from finished edge. Topstitch a second row 1/4" from previous stitching.
- 3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 for second napkin. *Tip:* Use a zigzag or decorative stitch to finish the napkin edges or use a contrasting thread for the topstitching.

Napkin Ring

- 1. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse the 3½" Fabrics A and B squares wrong sides together.
- 2. Cut out paper template for small napkin ring leaf (page 4) and pin to fused squares. Cut around the shape and remove paper template.
- 3. Using small leaf template as your guide, mark vein lines with water soluble marker.
- 4. Sew vein lines as desired. Repeat sewing close to first stitching lines. Topstitch around the leaf shape 1/8" from the edge and again 1/4" from the outer edge. Repeat a second row of topstitching. Remove vein line markings.
- 5. With right sides together, fold the 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric A strip in half lengthwise and press. Sew together at long edge and one short edge. Turn to right side through opening. Turn unfinished short end to wrong side ¼" and press. Topstitch around all four sides ¹/s" from the edge and again ¼" from the outer edge.
- 6. Position one hook side of tape close to the edge on one end of the napkin ring band and machine stitch in place. Turn the band over and position one loop side of tape close to the opposite end; stitch in place. Place leaf on sewn napkin ring as shown and topstitch down the center vein to attach to napkin ring (Dia. D).
- 7. Repeat steps to make second napkin ring.




