



# Bronwen Quilt

Finished size: 42 1/2" x 42 1/2"

## SUPPLIES NEEDED

- 1 pkg. Bronwen Strips (24 - 2 1/2" x 42")
- 2 - Quarter Yard Beige Lattice (18" x 21") (binding)
- 1 - One Yard White Tonal Dots (36" x 42")
- 2 - One Yard Purple Tonal Dots (36" x 42") (backing)
- 48" x 48" batting
- Coordinating thread
- Basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, self-healing mat
- Ruler, pencil, scissors
- Safety pins
- Sewing machine and iron
- Walking/even-feed foot (recommended)
- Iron and pressing surface

## BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Before cutting, press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting. Use a 1/4" seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## CUTTING

**White Tonal Dots:** 5 - 2 1/2" x wof"  
8 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"  
8 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"

**Beige Lattice:** 10 - 2 1/2" x 21" (binding)

**Purple Tonal Dots:** 1 - 5" x 36" (backing)  
4 - 6" x 23 1/2" (backing)  
1 - 36" x 42" (backing)

## SEWING

1. Place the Beige Lattice, Purple Solid, Aqua Floral, and Black Paisley strips (2 1/2" x wof) as shown in Diagram A. Pin RST lengthwise and sew to make Strip Set A; press. Repeat to make a total of three strip sets, measuring approximately 8 1/2" x 42".

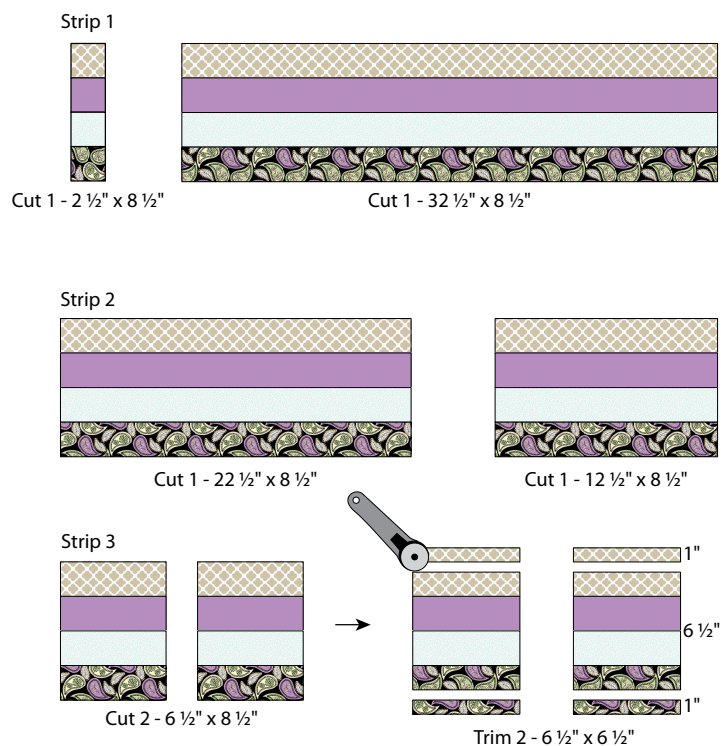

2. Straighten one end and subcut each Strip Set A into the number and size of units as shown in Diagram B. **Note:** *There will be some left over fabric from each strip.* Carefully cut equal amounts (approximately 1") from the top and bottom strips of each  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$  unit to make two  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$  squares.

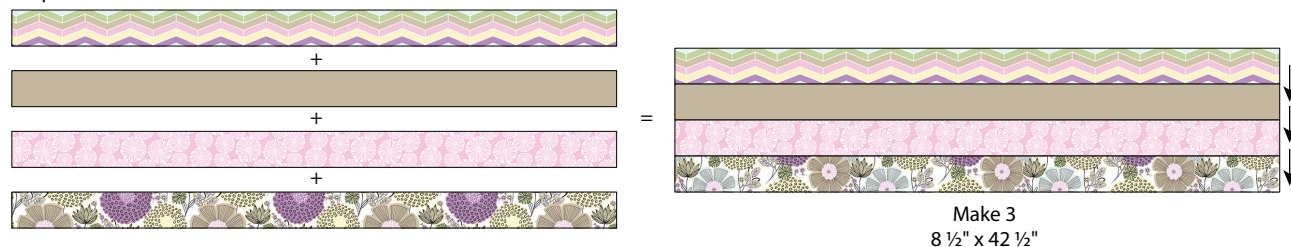

3. Place the Chevron, Beige Solid, Pink Flower, and Multi Flower strips ( $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{wof}$ ) as shown in Diagram C. Pin and sew RST lengthwise to make Strip Set B; press. Repeat to make a total of three strip sets, measuring approximately  $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 42\frac{1}{2}"$ .

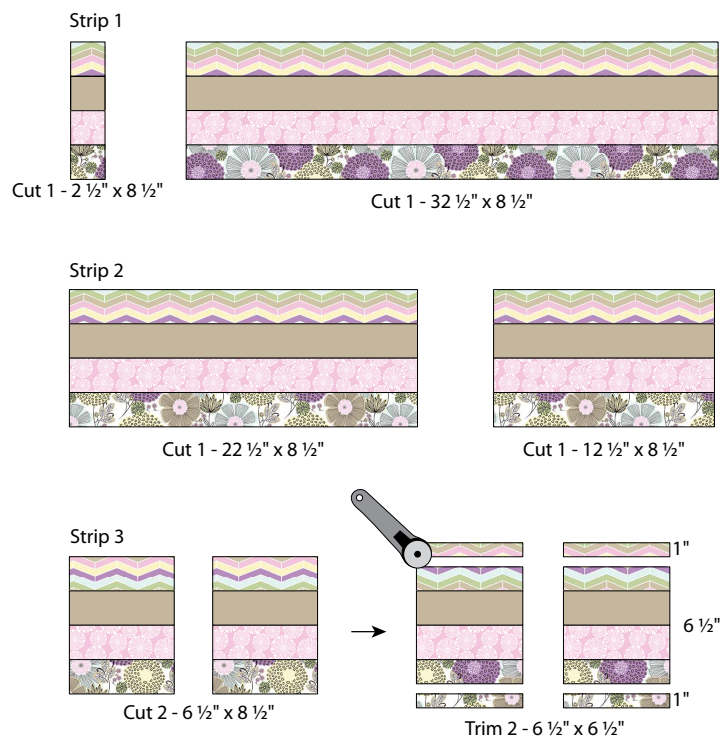

Strip Set B



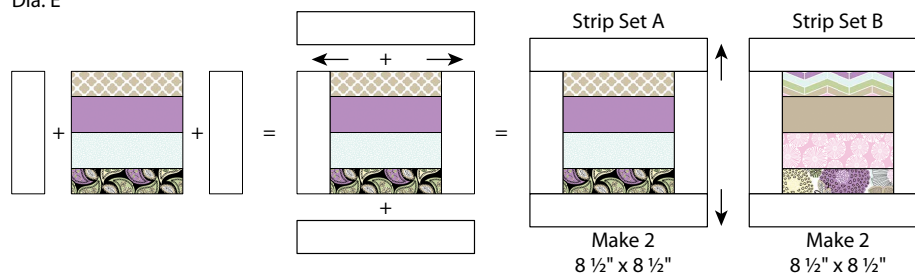
4. Straighten one end and subcut each Strip Set B into the number and size of units as shown in Diagram D. **Note:** *There will be some left over fabric from each strip.* Carefully cut equal amounts (approximately 1") from the top and bottom strips of each  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$  unit to make two  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$  squares.

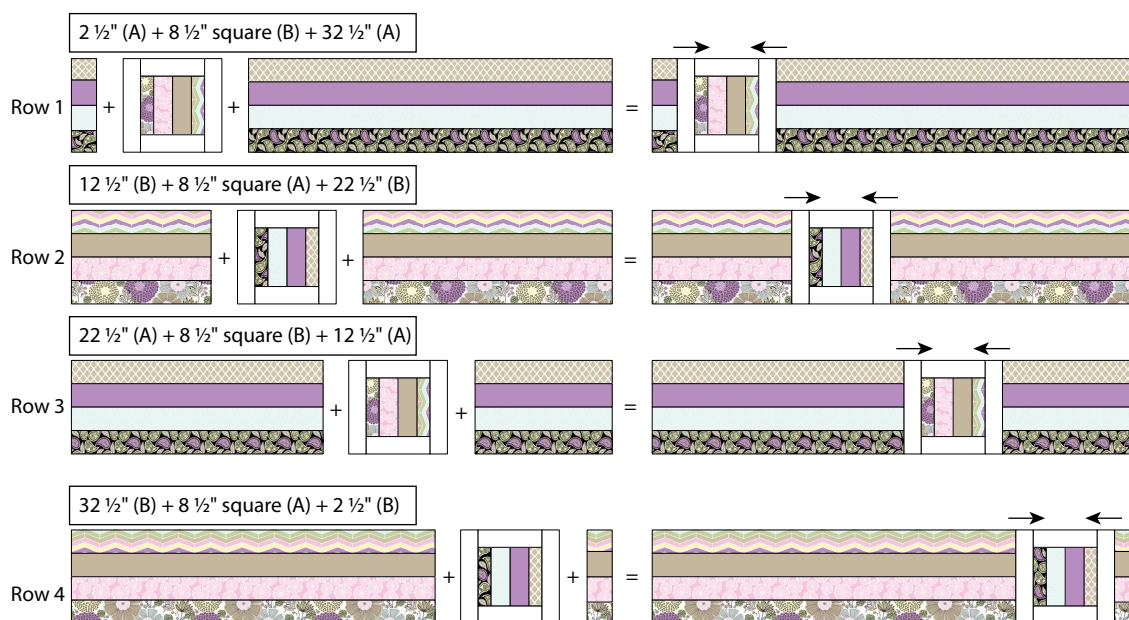
5. Pin and sew two White Tonal Dots strips ( $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ ) to opposite sides of a Strip Set A  $6\frac{1}{2}"$  square; press. Pin and sew two White Tonal Dots strips ( $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ ) to the top and bottom to make an  $8\frac{1}{2}"$  square; press. Repeat with the three remaining  $6\frac{1}{2}"$  squares and White Tonal Dots strips to make a total of two  $8\frac{1}{2}"$  squares for each Strip Set (Dia. E).

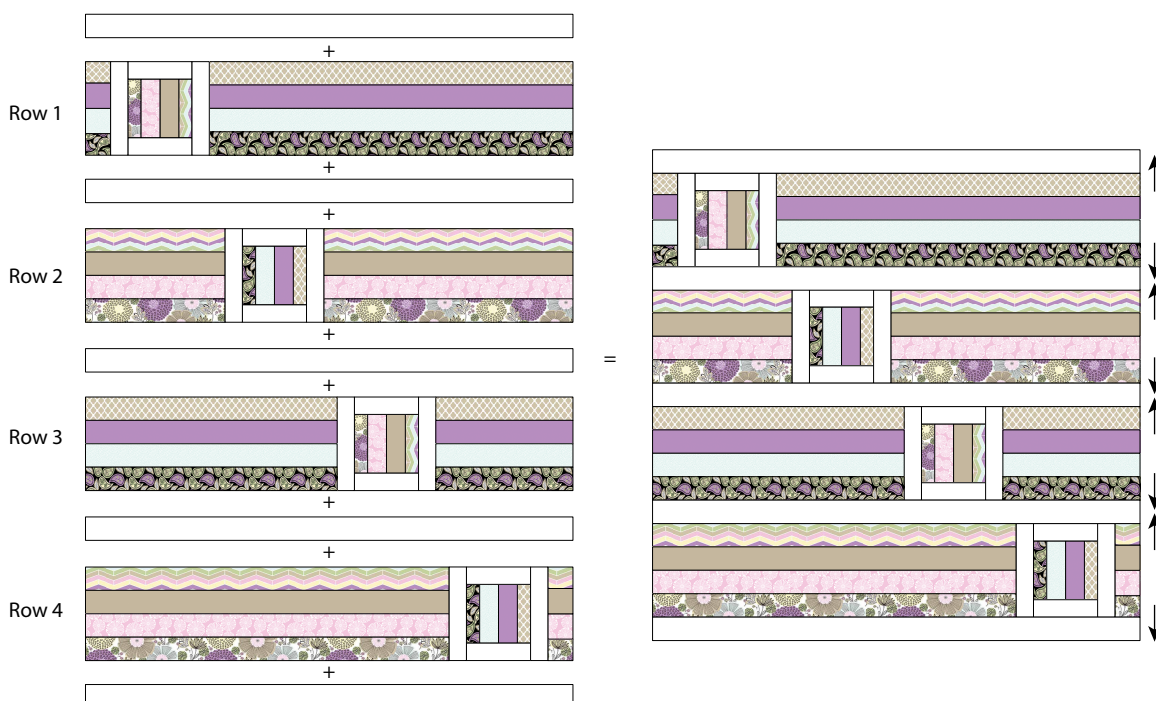
6. Follow Diagram F to pin the A and B Strip Set units and squares RST into Rows; sew and press. The rows should measure  $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 42\frac{1}{2}"$ .

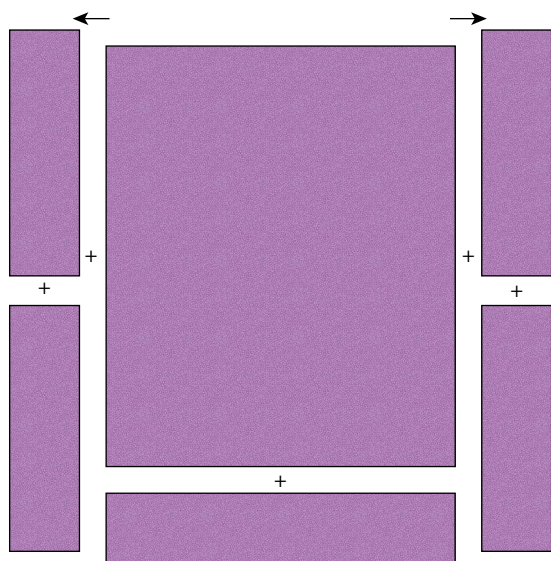
7. Follow Diagram G to lay out the quilt top, alternating the pieced rows with the White Tonal Dots sashing strips ( $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 42\frac{1}{2}"$ ). Beginning at the top, pin and sew the rows RST one at a time; press. The completed quilt top should measure  $42\frac{1}{2}" \times 42\frac{1}{2}"$ .

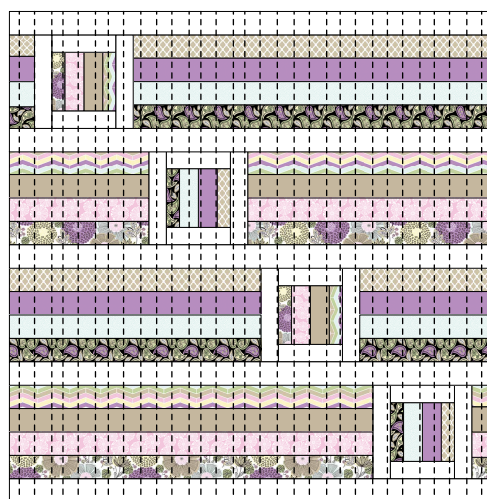


8. Follow Diagram H to sew the Purple Tonal Dots backing pieces (one 36" x 42", four 6" x 23 ½"; and one 5" x 36") RST to make the backing (46 ½" x 47 ½"); press.
9. Layer the backing **wrong** side up, the batting and top right side up. Starting at the center, baste the layers together with safety pins.
10. Follow Diagram I to quilt the three layers together or quilt as desired. A walking foot will help the layers to feed evenly. Stitch parallel vertical lines 1" apart. **Tip: Use 1" masking tape to help "mark" lines and stitch next to the edge. Remove after stitching.** Square up corners and edges, trimming excess backing and batting even with the quilt top.

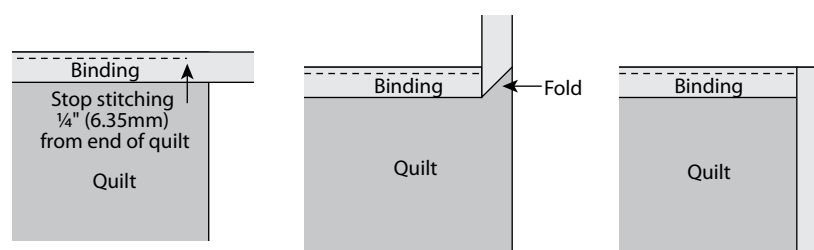

11. Pin short ends of the Beige Lattice binding strips (2 ½" x 21") RST end to end to make one continuous strip; sew and press seams open. Press one short end ¼" to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2" tail on the folded end, pin the cut edges of the folded binding even with the edge of the quilt top. Sew using a ¼" seam allowance and miter the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the binding. Fold binding over to the back and hand stitch in place.



## FINISHED CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Wash in cold water, gentle cycle. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry on low.
