

# Collar Dog Bandana

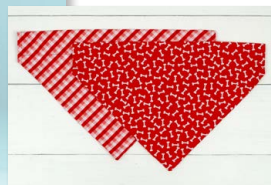
Finished Size: 14" (35.56cm) Collar  
9" (22.86cm) Length



## Supplies Needed

- 1 – 18" x 21" (45.72cm x 53.34cm) Fat Quarter
- Coordinating thread
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine
- Iron and pressing surface

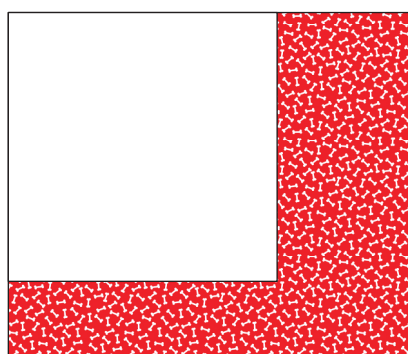


## Before You Begin

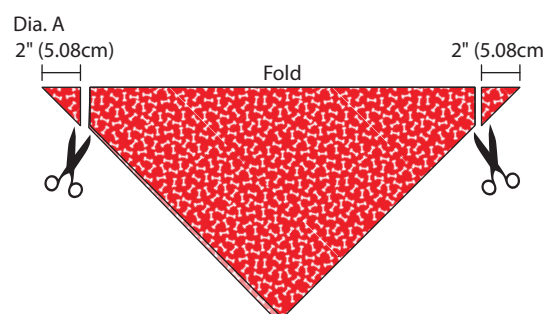
Read all instructions before beginning project. Prewash fabric if desired and line dry. Press fabric on cotton setting. Use a 1/4" (6.35mm) seam allowance and backstitch at the beginning and end of stitching.

## Cutting

1. Cut one square 14" x 14" (45.72cm x 45.72cm).
2. Fold square in half diagonally. Measure in 2" (5.08cm) and mark on each side of the folded edge as shown in Diagram A. Cut on the drawn lines.

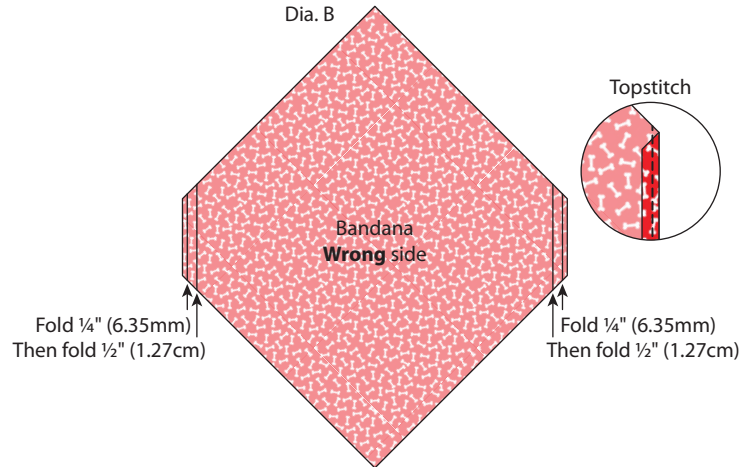


Fat Quarter 18" x 21" (45.72cm x 53.34cm)  
Cut 1 – 14" x 14" (35.56cm x 35.56cm)

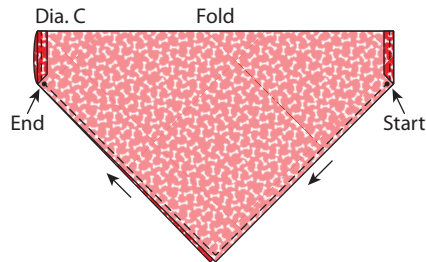


# Sewing

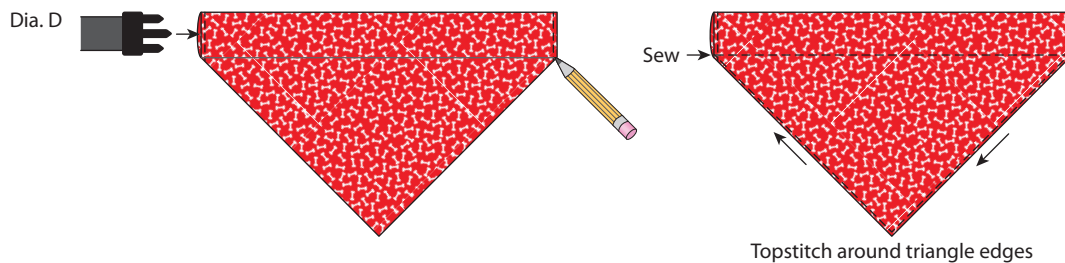
3. Open the square and fold the cut edges  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6.35mm) to the **wrong** side and again  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.27cm). Topstitch close to the inner fold to hem (Dia. B).



4. Fold right sides together and pin. Sew Scarf between hemmed edges as shown, leaving the collar channel open (Dia. C).



5. Turn Scarf right side out through the collar channel opening; smooth edges flat and press.
6. Insert dog's collar into opening and mark width, about  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " (4.45cm), from the folded edge. **Note:** Insert collar buckle to check that width will allow it to slide through. Sew on the marked line to make the collar channel, then continue a topstitch around Scarf edges.



## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash cold water, gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Hang to dry. Press if needed.
