



Pillowcase Trim

Makes two 3 1/2" x 20" trims

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- 1 - 1/4 Yard Cotton (Multi Feathers)
- Standard pillowcase (size 20" x 30")
- Coordinating thread
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine
- Iron

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not prewash fabric. Before cutting, press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting. Use a 1/4" seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

CUTTING

Cut 2 - 4" x 21" (trim)

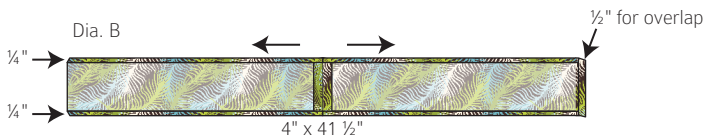
SEWING

1. Sew the two 4" x 21" trim strips RST on the short edges to make one long strip 4" x 41 1/2"; press seam open (Dia. A).

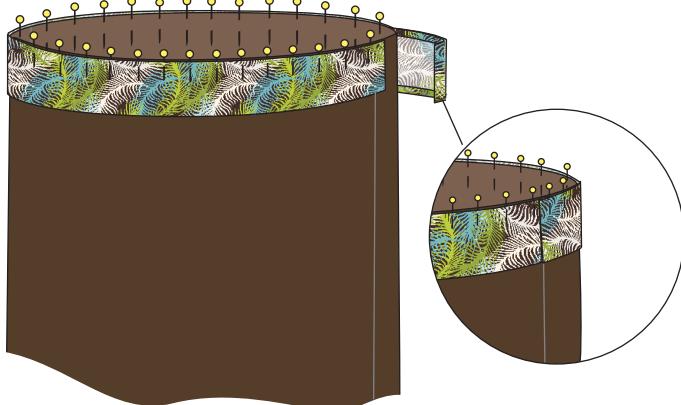


2. To hem, fold the long edges 1/4" to the wrong side; press. Press one short edge 1/2" to the wrong side (Dia. B).



3. Position the wrong side of the trim along the right side of the open edge of the pillowcase, with the flat edge of the trim 1/2" beyond the side seam; pin. Continue to pin the folded edge of the trim around the edge of the pillowcase (Dia. C). Overlap the folded short edge to cover the pinned flat edge; sew the top edge.

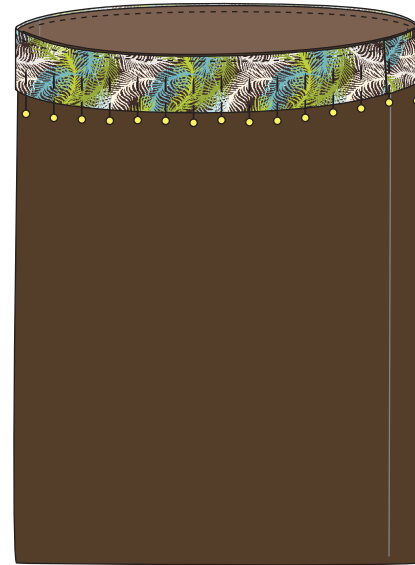

4. Pin the other long edge of the trim to the pillowcase. Topstitch around the bottom close to the edges and along the overlapped edge of the trim (Dia. D).

Repeat steps to trim a second pillowcase.

FINISHED CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Wash in cold water, gentle cycle, hang or lay flat to dry.
