



Fleece Wrap

Finished Size: 54" x 57" (One size fits most)



Supplies Needed

- 1½ yds fleece
(58" - 60" wide solid or non-directional print)
- Basic sewing supplies
- Yardstick
- Rotary cutter, mat, and acrylic ruler (optional)
- Sewing machine
- Removable marking pen or pencil
- Yarn or pearl cotton - *optional*

Instructions

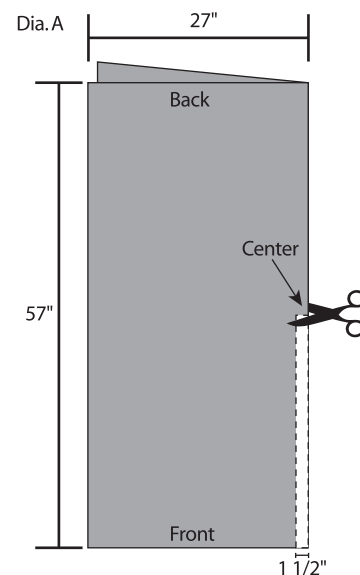
Before you begin: Read instructions completely before starting project. Take care not to stretch fleece while handling.

Cutting

1. Trim selvages evenly from both edges of fleece to make a piece approximately 54" x 57".
Note: The selvaige runs along the short sides of the yardage for this project. It may appear wavy or bumpy and have a line of small holes.
2. Fold in half with long edges matching. Fold in half in the opposite direction and mark center with a pin.
3. Unfold so that piece is approximately 27" x 57". Mark center opening and neckline 1 ½" from fold (Dia. A). Cut on marked lines.
4. Try on shawl. Trim width and/or length if desired.
5. Open shawl and lay flat; round off corners if desired. (**Tip:** Use a round household item like a small plate or a CD as a cutting guide.)

Finishing (Optional)

6. If desired, fold under all edges ½" to the wrong side and topstitch by machine to finish. To hand stitch, use yarn or pearl cotton with a large eyed needle to blanket stitch edges.
(Tip: To tell the right from the wrong side of fleece, hold your fabric by a horizontal or cross grain cut edge and pull gently. The edge will curl toward the wrong side of the fleece.)



Care instructions: Machine wash gentle cycle in cold water. Tumble dry on low or hang dry.
