

# Pinwheels

Finished Size: 6" Diameter (15.24cm)

**Note:** Each pair of 18" x 21" (45.72cm x 53.34cm) fat quarters will make six (6) pinwheels.



## Supplies Needed

- 2 Coordinating Fabric Palette® fat quarters (18" x 21", 45.72cm x 53.34cm)
- Removable marker (ex. Frixion Thermo ink pen)
- Heavyweight fusible web 18" x 21" (45.72cm x 53.34cm)
- 6 – Buttons: ½" (1.27cm) to ⅝" (1.59cm)
- Glue – hot glue or craft glue
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Iron, pressing surface and pressing cloth

## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Iron fabric to remove creases.

**Note:** Prewash if necessary or required by fusible web instructions.

Print template at 100% scale and check measurements after printing to ensure correct size. Cut out template along printed outside edges.

1. Follow manufacturer's instructions to adhere fusible web to the **wrong** side of one fabric; remove paper backing. Center the other fabric on the fusible side with the **wrong** side down and edges even. Press to create double-sided fabric. **Note:** Protect your ironing surface and iron with a pressing cloth (ex. plain muslin). Allow to cool.

## Cutting

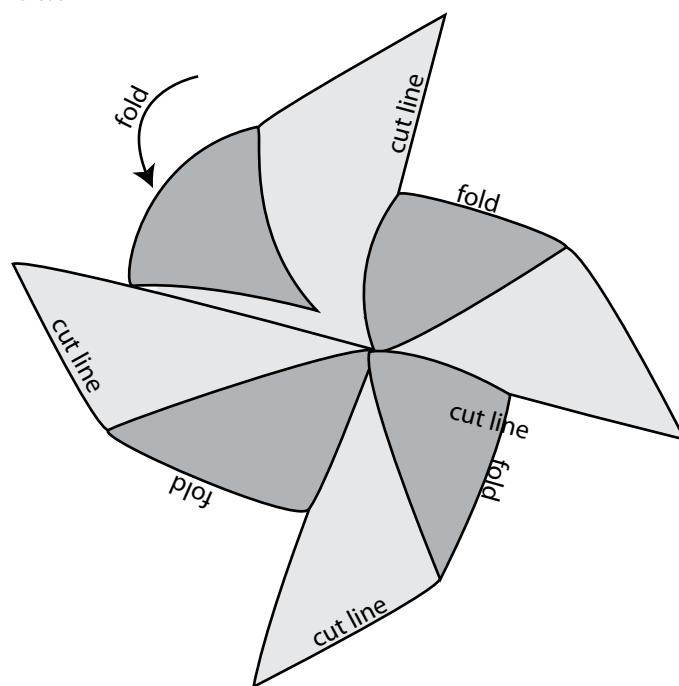
2. Cut six 6 ½" (16.51cm) squares from the fabric. Using the Pinwheel template and a removable marking pen, mark the center and cutting lines from the corners toward the center point. Cut along the four cutting lines.

# Assembly

3. Turn corners in so points meet in the center; overlap slightly. Use a small dot of glue and hold in place to secure (Dia. A). Allow to set.

**Tip: For matching pinwheels, take care to turn each corner as shown or turn as desired for different spin direction.**

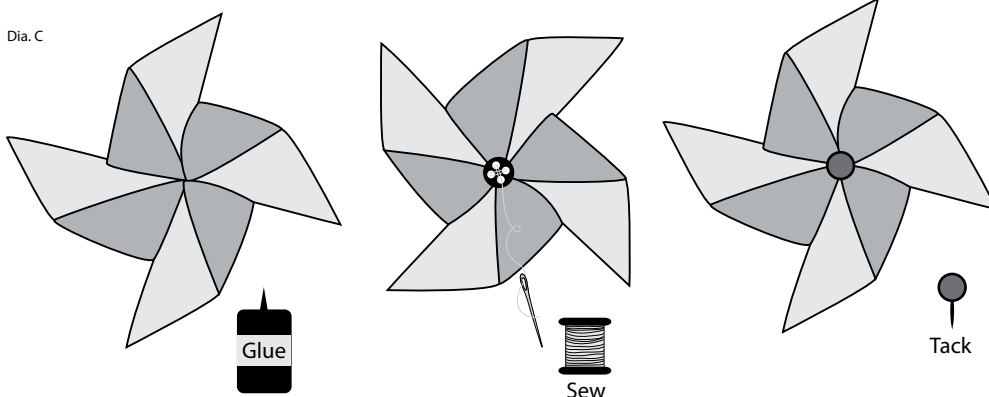


# Finishing

4. Refer to Diagram B for finishing options:

- Sew or glue a button embellishment in centers.
- Stitch with a double thread, catching all layers.
- Use a thumbtack to insert into a balsa wood dowel.
- Glue to skewer or chopstick.
- Sew or glue to ribbon for a garland.
- Use adhesive hook and loop tape to secure to gift packages.

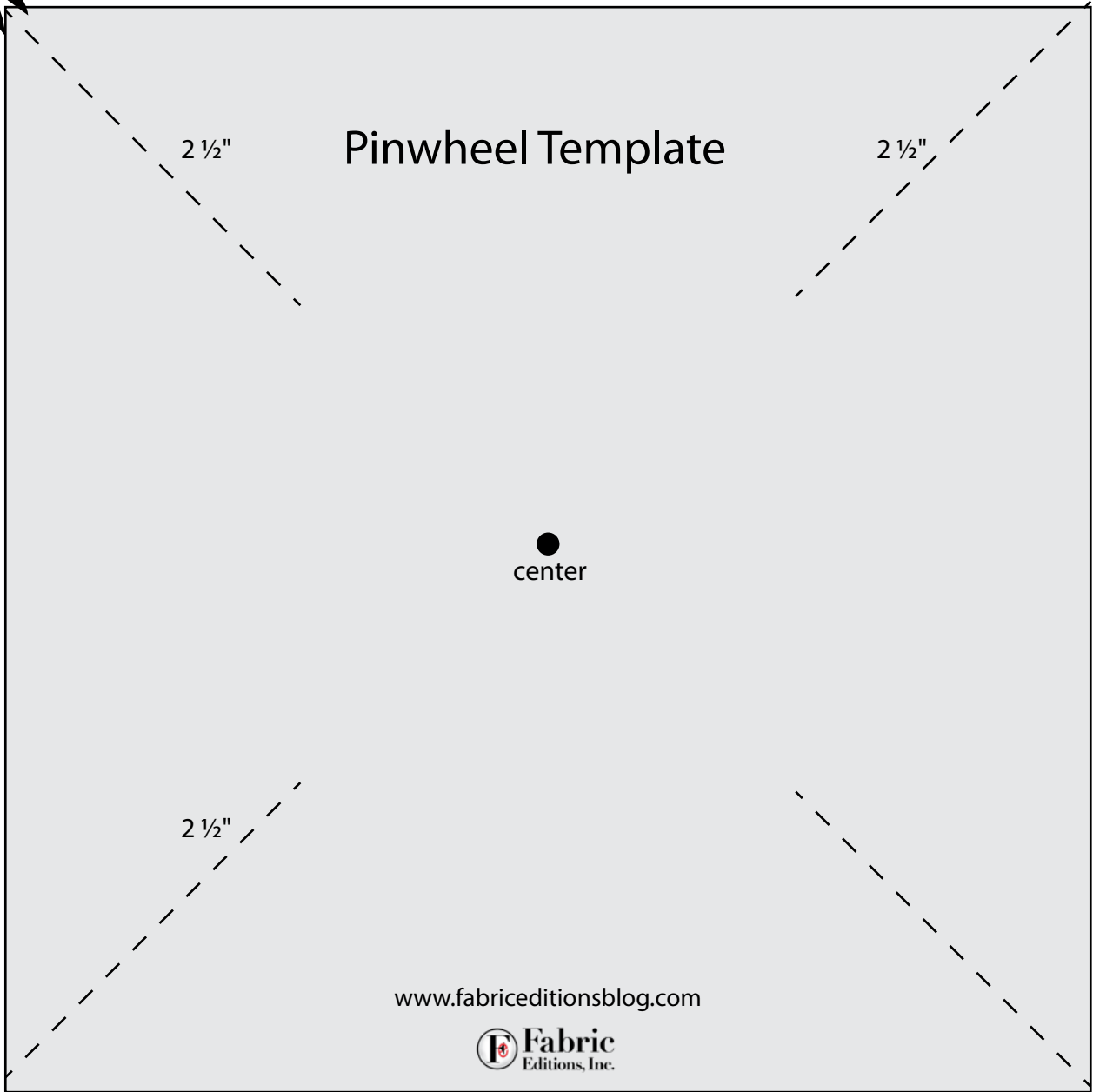


# Finished Care Instructions

Dust or wipe with cloth if needed. **Note:** Store with tissue in pinwheels to hold the shape.
