

Child's Name Hoop

Project Instructions

Finished Size: 6" Diameter



Personalize this quick and easy project with your child's name, favorite color, and critter.

Supplies Needed

- 1 Fabric Palette® Burlap (18" x 21") - Red
- 6" Wooden embroidery hoop
- 1 pkg. White Iron-on letters
- 1 Wood and felt critter shape
- Cotton pressing cloth
- Craft glue or glue gun and glue sticks
- Marker that will show on burlap
- Scissors
- Iron and pressing surface

Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabric before beginning project.

Cutting

Burlap: 1 - 8" x 8" (hoop background)

Constructing

1. Separate the two parts of the hoop. Set the inner hoop aside.
2. On the pressing surface, center the outer hoop on the burlap square.
3. Determine placement of the giraffe cutout shape on the burlap.
4. Remove the iron-on letters of desired name from the sheet and place them as desired on burlap within the hoop.
5. Carefully remove the giraffe cutout and hoop without disturbing the letters.
6. Place the cotton pressing cloth over the letters and fuse securely in place following the manufacturer's instructions.
7. Place the inner hoop on a firm surface with the burlap square centered on top. **Note:** Check that placement of letters is correct.
8. Set outer hoop over the design area then place the wooden cutout shape. When design is centered, remove giraffe cutout, push outer hoop over the inner hoop; pull burlap taut. **Note:** Check that letters are still in correct position; if not, remove hoop, adjust and re-hoop. Tighten the screw.

9. Trim burlap $\frac{3}{4}$ " beyond the hoop. Glue neatly to inside of hoop.
10. Glue giraffe cutout shape to front of the burlap.

Finishing

11. Hang hoop using a small nail.

Finished Care Instructions

Dust gently as needed.
