

Paci - Bib



Finished Size: 8" x 15 1/2"

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Supplies Needed


- 1 Fabric Palette® Fat Quarter (18" x 21") cotton
- 1 Fabric Palette[®] Cozy Plush (30" x 36")
- ³⁄4" Hook-and-loop tape 1"
- Coordinating thread
- Removable fabric marker
- Clear tape
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine
- Iron and pressing surface
- Pressing cloth
- Walking foot (optional)

Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not prewash fabrics. Before cutting press cotton fabric with a dry iron. Press plush with a damp pressing cloth if needed. *Note: Pressing directly on plush may damage fabric*. Use a ¼" seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. *Note: When printing, check that page size is set to actual size and compare printout with the template measurements noted in cutting section below.*

Zutting

- 1. Print Paci-Bib template pieces and tape together along dashed lines. Cut out along printed outside edge. (Template size: 8 ³/₄" x 16 ¹/₂")
- 2. Cut 2 hook and loop tape pieces to 1/2" x 3/4".
- 3. Place cotton fabric on top of cozy plush RST. Place the Paci-Bib template on the **wrong** side of cotton fabric; pin well, trace around template and cut out (Dia. A). **Note:** Cozy plush has a nap, which means the fabric will lay flat in one direction. Have the nap lay flat towards the bottom of bib. Remove template.







- 4. Pin well RST and sew ¹/₄" around the outside edges leaving a 4" opening on one side for turning; clip curves and turn right side out (Dia. B). *Tip:* Using a walking foot will help keep the fabrics from shifting when sewing.
- 5. Use a pressing cloth to press on the cotton side of the Paci-Bib. Topstitch close to edge, sewing the opening closed.
- 6. Pin the hook (rough) side of the hook-and-loop tape to the back side of the left neck tab; sew around edges. Pin loop (soft) side to the front side of the right neck tab. Check that they line up and sew around edges (Dia. C).
- 7. To make the loop for the pacifier, refer to the pattern to pin the hook (rough) side of the hookand-loop tape to the Paci-Bib back and the loop (soft) side on the Paci-Bib back as shown on Template C. Check that they line up then sew around edges (Dia. D)


Finished Care Instructions


Machine wash cold, gentle cycle. Tumble dry low or hang to dry.
