- $2 / 3$ yard $(60.96 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ - 17317-TRQ-CTN-D (Koala Bears)
- $1 / 3$ yard $(30.48 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ - 17321-TRQ-CTN-D (Pineapples)
- $1 / 4$ yard ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) - 17319-MLT-CTN-D (Allover Floral)

## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 69" x 75" (175.26cm x 190.50 cm ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Befare Yau Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4 "(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Label blocks as they are made. wof $=$ width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.


Plumes ( $17316-$ MLT-CTN-D) $11 / 4$ yards ( $114.3 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $7-51 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$



Navy Posy ( $17265-$ NVY-CTN-D) $11 / 4$ yards ( $114.3 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $10-2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $7-21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ Binding


Koala Bears ( $17317-$ TRQ-CTN-D) $2 / 3$ yard ( $60.96 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $15-61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$

36" Panel (17318-MLT-CTN-D) 1 yard ( $87.63 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Fussy Cut $1-331 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 391 / 22^{\prime \prime}(85.09 \mathrm{~cm} \times 100.33 \mathrm{~cm})$

Pineapples ( $17321-T R Q-C T N-D) 1 / 3$ yard ( $\mathbf{3 0 . 4 8} \mathrm{cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 4-2" x 42" $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

Allover Floral ( $17319-$ MLT-CTN-D) $1 / 4$ yard ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 2-3 ½" x 42" (8.89cm x 106.68cm)

## Seming

1. Refer to Diagram A to sew one Navy Posy strip ( $2^{\prime \prime} \times 391 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 100.33 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to each side of the Panel ( $331 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 391 / 2^{\prime \prime} /$ $85.09 \mathrm{~cm} \times 100.33 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew one Navy Posy strip ( 2 " $\times 361 / 2 " / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to the top and to the bottom of the Panel to make the Quilt Center.
2. Refer to Diagram B to sew one Pineapples strip ( $2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " / $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to each side of one White Lace strip ( 3 1/2" $\times 42$ " / $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make one Strip Set 1. Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.
3. Refer to Diagram $C$ to cut thirty $2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2{ }^{1 / 2}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ Unit 1 strips from the two Strip Set 1 's.

4. Refer to Diagram D to sew one White Lace strip (2" $\times 42$ " / $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to each side of one Allover Floral strip ( $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " / $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make one Strip Set 2. Repeat to make a second Strip Set 2.
5. Refer to Diagram E to cut fifteen $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 "(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ Unit 2 strips from the Strip Set 2's.
6. Refer to Diagram F to sew one Unit 1 strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 2 strip to make one $61 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ Block One square. Repeat to make fifteen Block One squares total.
7. Refer to Diagram $G$ to sew together four Block One squares and three Koala Bears squares ( $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border. The Left Side Border should measure $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2 "$ ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
8. Refer to Diagram $H$ to sew together four Koala Bears squares ( $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and three Block One squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Right side Border. The Right Side Border should measure $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

9. Refer to Diagram I to sew together four Koala Bears squares ( $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 " / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and four Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. The Top Border and Bottom Border should each measure $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2 "(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm})$.

10. Refer to Diagram J to sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the right and to the left of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure $481 / 22^{\prime \prime} 541 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (123.19cm x 138.43 cm ).

11. Sew three Navy Posy strips ( 2 " $\times 42$ " / $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " ( 6.35 mm ). From the sewn strip cut two Navy Posy strips ( $2^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 2 / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Refer to Diagram K to sew one Navy Posy strip ( 2 " x $541 / 2 " / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew three Navy Posy strips ( 2 " x 42" / 5.08cm x 106.68 cm ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4 "(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip cut two Navy Posy strips ( 2 " x $51 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 130.81 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Refer to Diagram K to sew one Navy Posy strip ( 2 " x $511 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 130.81 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure $511 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 571 / 2 "(130.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 146.65 \mathrm{~cm})$.

12. Sew three Plumes strips ( $51 / 2 " \times 42^{\prime \prime} / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " ( 6.35 mm ). From the sewn strip cut two Plumes strips ( $51 / 2 " \times 571 / 2 " / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 146.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Refer to Diagram L to sew one Plumes Border strip ( $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 571 / 2 " / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 146.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew four Plumes strips ( $51 / 2$ " $\times 42$ " / 13.97cm $\times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4 "(6.35 \mathrm{~mm}$ ). From the sewn strip cut two Plumes strips ( $51 / 2$ " x 61 1/2" / $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 156.21 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew one Plumes Border strip ( $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 156.21 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center to make the completed Quilt Top. The Quilt Top should measure $611 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 2 "(156.21 . \mathrm{cm} \times 171.45 \mathrm{~cm})$.

13. To make the Animal Phrases Multi Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces $42^{\prime \prime} \times 69$ " $(106.68 \mathrm{~cm} \times 172.72 \mathrm{~cm})$. Note: Check the direction of fabric. Pin and sew the pieces RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram M. Trim the back to measure 69" $\times 75$ " ( $175.26 \mathrm{~cm} \times 190.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

14. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing fabric. Tape the Backing wrong side up on a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
15. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
16. To make the Navy Posy Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips RST and to end at a 45 degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ " ( 6.35 mm ) to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 " 5.08 cm ) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.


Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
