

Pillowcase Pair

Finished Size: 21" x 29 ½"



Supplies Needed

- 2 - 1yd Coordinating fabrics (36" x 42")
- 1 Pkg. Coordinating piping
- Coordinating threads
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine
- Zipper foot (for piping)
- Iron

Instructions

Before you begin: Read instructions completely before beginning project. Prewash fabrics. Use a zigzag or serge stitch to finish seams.

Cutting

Fabric A: 1 - 26" x 41", (pillowcase body); 1 - 9" x 41" (pillowcase cuff)

Fabric B: 1 - 26" x 41", (pillowcase body); 1 - 9" x 41" (pillowcase cuff)

Sewing

1. Using a 5/8" seam, sew piping on the right side of Fabric A pillowcase body along one long edge using a zipper foot. Fold pillowcase body in half with right sides together so that short edges meet. Using a ½" seam, sew along the long edge and the short edge without piping. Clip corners and turn the pillowcase right side out. Repeat for the second pillowcase body using Fabric B.
2. Press Fabric B pillowcase cuff in half lengthwise with wrong sides together so that long edges meet. Press 5/8" under on one long edge; open cuff and lay flat.
3. Fold pillowcase cuff with right sides together so that short ends meet; sew short end.
4. Insert the flat edge of the cuff inside Fabric A pillowcase with RIGHT side of cuff facing WRONG side of pillowcase, matching seams and aligning raw edges. Sew and press seam toward cuff.
5. Fold the pressed edge of the cuff over to the right side of pillowcase so that the pressed edge meets the piping; pin. Topstitch along edge to finish the pillowcase.
6. Repeat steps to make second pillowcase.

Care instructions: Machine wash gentle cycle in cold water. Tumble dry on low or hang dry.
