## Supplies Needed

- 1 Fabric Central® Garden Play Bundle 1
- ½ vd Pellon® 809 Décor Bond™
- Four 1" decorative buttons
- Eight %" decorative buttons
- Rotary cutter, mat, acrylic ruler
- Basic sewing supplies
- · Sewing machine
- Iron, pressing surface



## Instructions

Read all instructions before beginning project. Sew all pieces together with a ¼" seam allowance and right sides together unless directed otherwise. Press seams with a dry iron on the cotton setting in the direction of arrows.

- 1. Pair up fat quarters from the Fabric Central bundle, coordinating colors and designs. One will be the lining, and one will be the outside of the bin. Layer with right sides together.
- 2. Cutting: For the large size, from one layered pair, cut a  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $17\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. To make two smaller bins, cut a  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14" rectangle from each pair. Keep the paired rectangles together. From the Décor Bond<sup>TM</sup>, cut one 14" x 17" rectangle and two 11" x  $13\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Cut a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square from every corner of the Décor Bond<sup>TM</sup> rectangles.
- 3. Center the Décor Bond™ on top of the wrong side of one fabric from each pair, shiny adhesive side down (dia. a). Using a pressing cloth and following the manufacturer's direction, fuse in place.
- 4. Keeping the pairs together, pin around the sides. Leaving a 6" opening on one side, sew around sides. Turn right side out and press. Slipstitch opening closed. *Optional: Topstitch close to edge with coordinating thread.*
- 5. On the lining bin fabric, lightly mark a  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " line from each edge (dia. b). Sew on line to create a folding guide line. Press along sides to define fold.




## Project Instructions Continued

- 6. To make corners, fold up sides, matching the folding guidelines. Pin and sew over guideline stitches (dia. c).
- 7. Fold down the corner and center over the seam. Stitch a decorative button to hold in place (dia. d). Use four large buttons on the large bin, and 8 smaller buttons on the pair of smaller bins.
