

Faux Fur Boot Toppers & Scarf



Finished Project Size:

Two Boot Toppers – 4 1/2" x 13" (maximum circumference)

Scarf – 5" x 49" (including fringe)

Supplies Needed

- 1 pkg. Faux Fur (18" x 28")
- 2 - 18" x 21" Pre-cuts (lining)
- 1 pkg. Elastic (1/4")
- Coordinating thread
- Safety pin
- Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies
- Iron

Instructions

Before you begin: Read directions completely before beginning project. Use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted. (**Note:** Check that nap on fur pieces is going in the same direction before sewing.)

Cutting

(**Note:** For best use of faux fur, layout as shown.)

Cut with fur side down.)

Fur: 2 - 6 1/2" x 14" (boot topper)

2 - 5 1/2" x 24" (scarf)

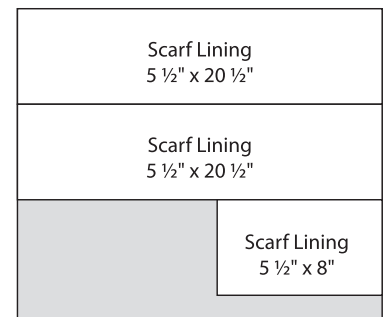
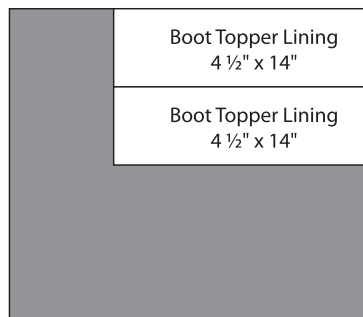
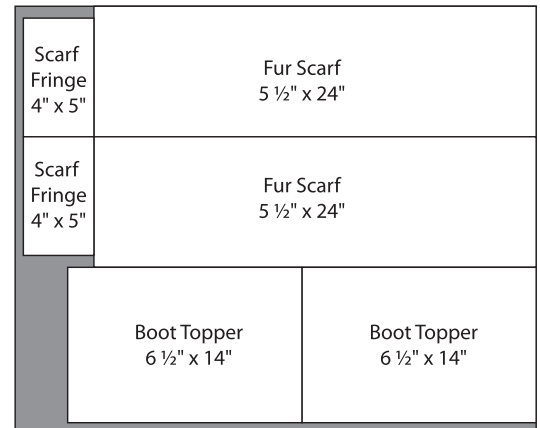
2 - 4" x 5" (scarf fringe)

Fabric: 2 - 4 1/2" x 14" (boot topper lining)

2 - 5 1/2" x 20 1/2" (scarf lining)

1 - 5 1/2" x 8" (scarf lining)

Elastic: 4 - Boot top circumference



Care instructions: Spot clean when needed.



Sewing

Boot Topper

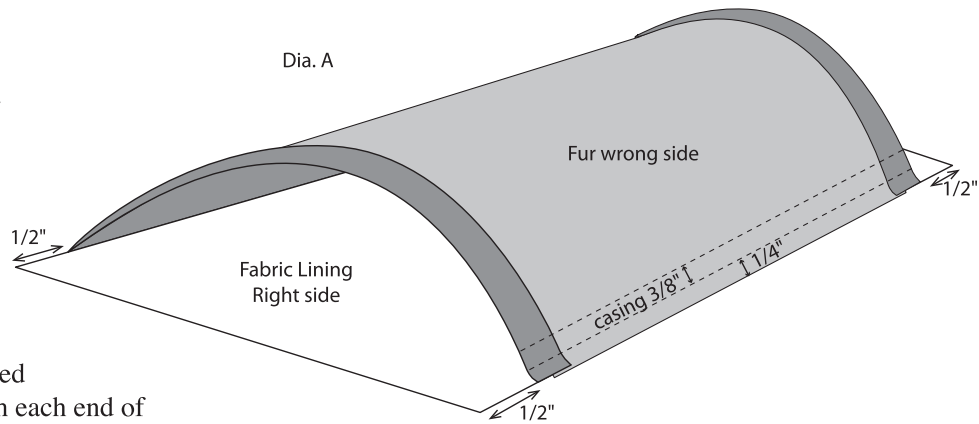
1. At each short end of a boot topper, fold the fur 1/2" to the wrong side; baste.

2. Place boot topper and lining with right sides together and pin along one long edge. Lining will extend 1/2" on each short end; sew. To create casing, sew again 3/8" from first row of stitching (Dia. A). Repeat for the other long edge.

3. Attach a safety pin to one end of elastic and feed through casing. Pin each end of elastic even with each end of lining and stitch securely. Repeat for the other long edge of boot topper. Turn right side out.

4. Pin short edges of lining right sides together and stitch using a 1/2" seam. Tuck the lining seam inside the boot topper and hand stitch folded edges of fur together. (**Tip:** Use a pin to pull the fur out of the seam.)

5. Repeat steps 1 - 4 to make the second boot topper.



Scarf

1. Sew two short ends of fur scarf pieces together.

2. With wrong sides together, fold fur fringe pieces in half so that 5" edges meet; sew close to cut edge (Dia. B).

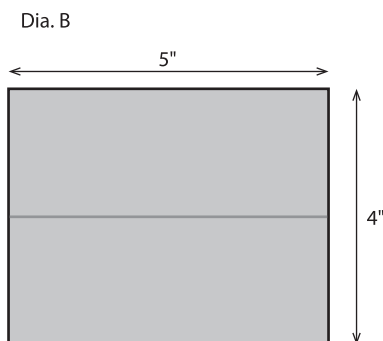
3. Center a fur fringe piece on the right side of the fur scarf at each end with raw edges even. Scarf will extend 1/4" on each side of fringe; sew. (**Tip:** Pin or baste the fringe at each end away from the sides to prevent catching it in the seam when sewing lining to scarf.)

4. Sew one short end of each 5 1/2" x 20 1/2" lining piece to a short end of the 5 1/2" x 8" piece, leaving a 2 1/2" opening in the center of one seam for turning. Press seams open. (**Note:** The smallest lining piece is in the middle.)

5. Place fur and lining with right sides together and stitch around all edges.

6. Turn right side out through opening in lining seam. Remove pins (basting) and hand stitch opening closed. Carefully press lining side only.

8. Cut fringe pieces at 1" intervals to just below the seam to create fur fringe (Dia. C).



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
