

"Fly" Mini-Banner



Finished Project Size: 5 1/2" x 36"

Supplies Needed

- 4 - 18" x 21" Pre-cuts (coordinating)
- 1 pkg. HeatnBond® UltraHold fusible web
- 1 1/2 yds. ribbon
- Dimensional fabric paint in desired colors
- Paper for patterns and pencil
- Scissors
- Iron

Instructions

Before you begin: Read all instructions.

CUTTING

Fabric A: Pennants (use template to cut in Step 2)

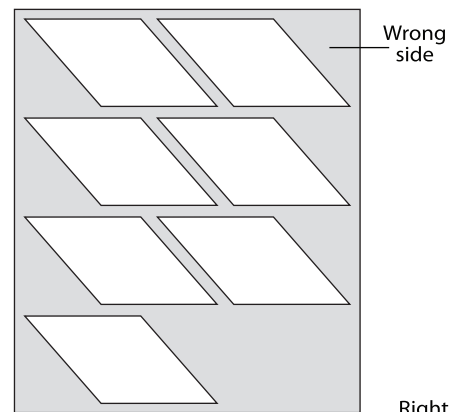
Fabric B-D: Bugs, word and word shadow appliqués (use templates)

1. Trace templates on page 3 and label; cut out.

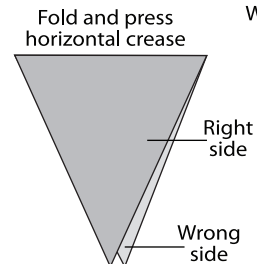
CONSTRUCTING

2. Place pennant template on the wrong side of Fabric A and trace seven diamond-shaped pennants as shown (Dia. A). **Note:** The long edges of pennants must be parallel to an 18" edge of the fabric in order to fit all seven pennants.
3. With the wrong side facing up, fold each pennant in half lengthwise (Dia. B) and press a center crease. Fold each pennant in half widthwise and press fold firmly to mark a placement crease (Dia. C).
4. Trace seven triangles from the "Template for Fusible Web" on paper side of fusible web. Cut out on lines and set aside.

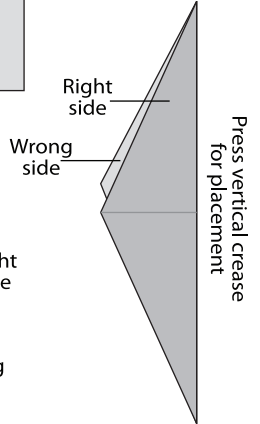

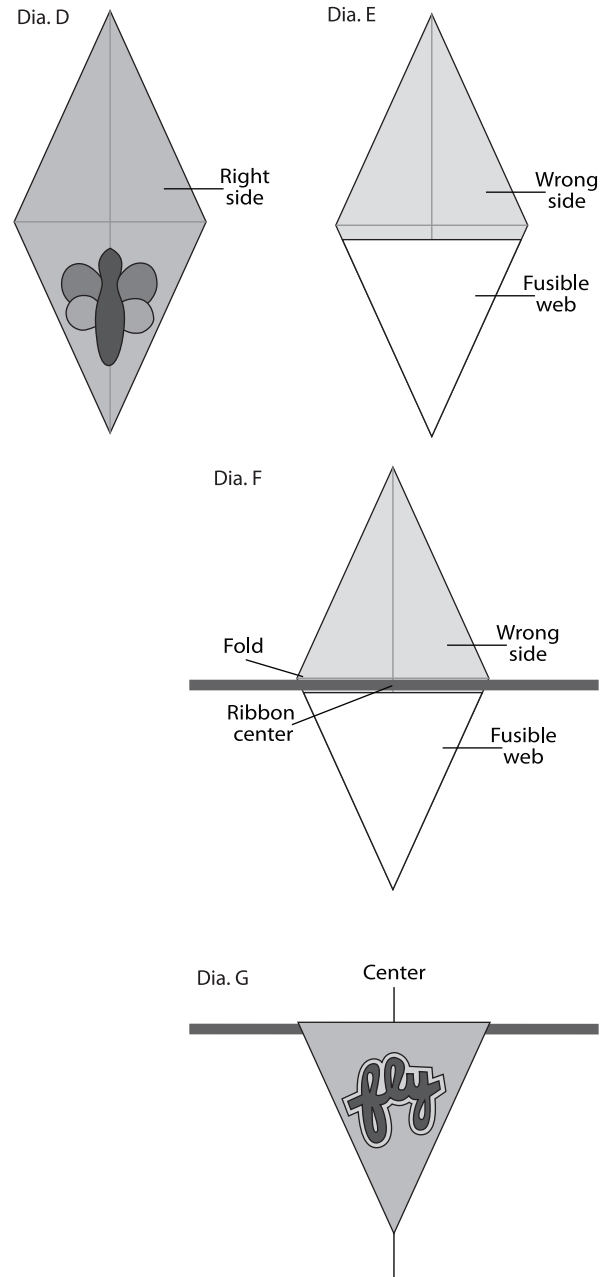


Care instructions: Shake or vacuum gently if needed.

- Trace patterns for bugs, word, and word shadow on fusible web as indicated on each piece. Cut around each piece loosely. Place on wrong side of chosen fabric. Fuse, then cut out on drawn lines. Remove paper backings
- Lay pennants right side up on the ironing surface. Arrange the appliqué using the creases for placement (Dia. D). **Note:** *Be sure to leave about 1/2" - 3/4" from the horizontal center crease for adding painted antennae to bugs.* Fuse according to manufacturer's instructions. Make a total of seven pennants: one "fly" and two each of dragonfly, butterfly, and bee designs.
- Turn pennants over so that the wrong sides are facing up and the fused designs are on the top half of each diamond. Iron the previously prepared fusible web triangles to the bottom half of each diamond shape (Dia. E). Remove paper backings.

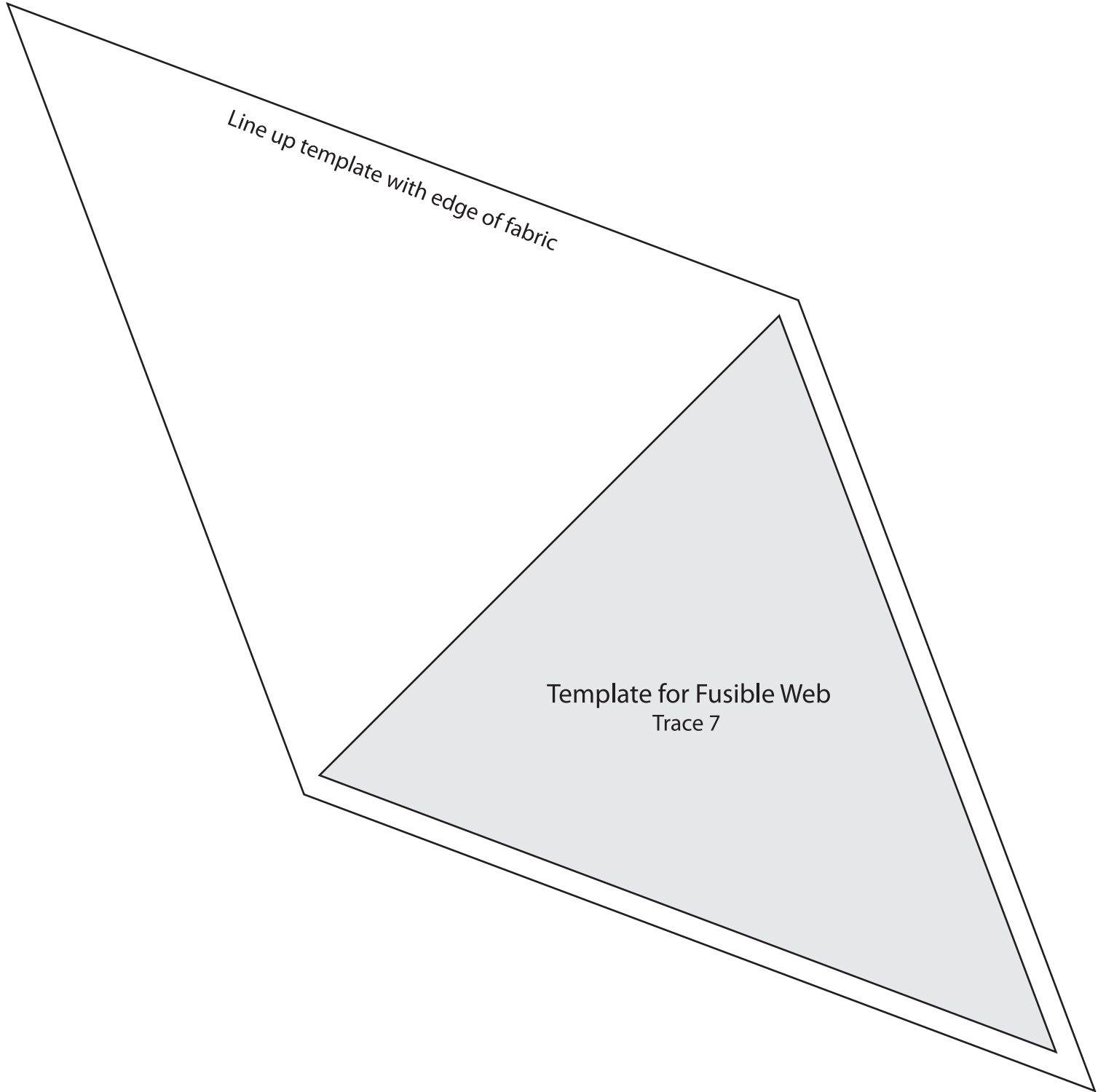
FINISHING

- Fold the ribbon in half to find the center. With the "fly" pennant wrong side up, place the top edge of the ribbon along horizontal fold matching centers (Dia. F). Fold pennant in half with edges matching to form a triangle, and fuse layers together to hold the ribbon in place (Dia. G). Referring to photo, add remaining pennants to ribbon as previously done.
- Lightly sketch in lines for antennae and other details, if desired. Add details with dimensional paint. **Tip:** *Practice on scrap fabric first. Leave banner flat while paint dries completely.*
- Tie a loop at each ribbon end and hang banner as desired.
