

Project Instructions

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Gírl's Dress & Shoulder Bag

Finished Sizes: Dress – 21" (length) Shoulder Bag - 1 1/2" x 5" x 6"

Supplies Needed

- 1 Super Singles (2 36" x 42" pcs.)
- 1 pkg. Elastic, 1/4"
- 1 pkg. Cover buttons/tools size 30 (3/4")
- Cardboard 1 1/2" x 5" (shoulder bag bottom)
- Coordinating thread
- Chalk pencil
- Craft glue
- Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies
- Iron
- Safety pin

Instructions

Before you begin: Read directions completely before beginning project. Use a 1/2" seam allowance unless otherwise noted. Finish seams using zigzag or serge stitching.


Cutting

(Note: Label pieces after cutting.) Fabric A:

- 2 15" x 21" (dress front & back)
- 1 8" x 16" (shoulder bag)
- 1 4" x 6" (shoulder bag bottom)
- 1 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" (shoulder bag band)
- 2 1 1/2" x 5" (pocket bands)
- 6 Large flowers (use template)
- 3 1 1/2" Cover button circles (use template)

(Note: To cut flowers using leftover fabrics, fold fabric piece with wrong sides together, pin the templates to the fabric, and cut out shape to create three two-sided flowers of each size. (See cutting charts.)

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Care instructions: Machine wash in cold water, gentle cycle; tumble dry low or hang to dry. Warm iron if needed.

Cutting (continued)

Fabric B:


- 2 5" x 42" (dress ruffle)
- 1 8" x 16" (shoulder bag lining)
- 1 1" x 42" (dress bindings/shoulder ties)
- 1 6 1/2" x 13" (shoulder bag flap)
- 1 3 1/2" x 25" (shoulder bag strap)
- 2 7" x 15" (dress front & back yoke)
- 2 5" x 9" (dress pockets)
- 1 1 1/2" x 20" (dress bow)
- 6 Small flowers (use template)


Sewing


Dress:

- 1. Measure in 3" from each side on one long edge of dress front and mark using a chalk pencil. Measure down 4" from the top on each side and mark. Draw a line connecting the marks on each side. Trim off each corner by cutting along the line (Dia. A). Repeat for dress back.
- 2. Fold the yoke front with wrong sides together so that long edges meet; press and baste. Repeat for yoke back.
- 3. On the right side of the dress front, place the yoke front on the top edge with raw edges even; sew. Press seam toward dress. Repeat for yoke back.
- 4. Measure 3/8" from folded edge of yoke and topstitch to create top casing.
- 5. Measure 3/8" from bottom seam of yoke and topstitch to create bottom casing (Dia. B).

6. Cut two pieces of elastic 7 1/2" (half the width of the yoke) for the top casings. (*Note: Yoke width can be adjusted by lengthening or shortening elastic pieces.*) Attach safety pin to one end of elastic and feed one piece through each top casing; stitch securely at each end.











Project Instructions Continued



- 7. Cut two pieces of elastic 9 1/2" (top elastic measurement + two inches) for the bottom casings and feed through bottom casings
- 8. Place dress front and back with right sides together; sew side seams. Press seam open.
- 9. Fold bindings/shoulder ties so that short edges meet to find the center; mark. With wrong sides together, fold so that long edges meet; press. Open and press all edges in 1/4" to the wrong side.
- 10. On the wrong side of the dress, pin the right side of the binding/shoulder tie along the underarm edge, matching the center mark to the side seam; sew using a 1/4" seam. Fold the binding over to the right side of the dress; baste.
- 11. Pin the shoulder ties with pressed edges even and topstitch close to the edge, continuing along binding to the other end of shoulder tie. Repeat for the other binding/shoulder tie (Dia. C).
- 12. Fold each dress ruffle piece in half so that short edges meet; mark at the fold to indicate the center of the ruffle top. Repeat to mark the center along the bottom edge of the dress front & back.
- 13. Place dress ruffle pieces with right sides together; pin short ends and sew. Hem the bottom edge (without the center mark) by pressing the edge under 1/4" to the wrong side. Fold under 1/4" again to the wrong side; topstitch.
- 14. Stitch 1/4" from the top edge of the dress ruffle using a long stitch for gathering. Stitch again 1/2" from the top edge. Pull bobbin threads to gather edge.
- 15. With right sides together, place gathered edge of ruffle along bottom edge of dress, matching center marks and side seams. Adjust gathers evenly; sew.
- 16. Fold pocket bands in half with wrong sides together, so that long edges meet; press. Open and press both long edges 1/4" to wrong side; fold in half again so that pressed edges meet; baste. Repeat for second pocket band.
- 17. Place a band 2" from one short edge of each pocket and topstitch in place.
- 18. Fold each pocket in half with right sides together so that short edges meet. Sew around side and bottom edges, leaving a 1" opening at the bottom for turning. Trim corners and turn right side out; sew opening closed and press. Repeat for second pocket.
- 19. For pocket placement, measure 3" from bottom seam and 3" from side seam. Pin and topstitch pockets to dress.
- 20. Place two small flowers with wrong sides together and topstitch 1/8" from edge. Repeat to create another small flower and two large flowers.
- 21. Cover two buttons following manufacturer's instructions. Layer a small flower on top of a large flower, center on top of the pocket band and pin. Sew a button to the center of the flowers, stitching through all layers. Repeat for other pocket.
- 22. Press dress bow in half so that long edges meet. Open and press all edges 1/4" to the wrong side. Fold in half so that pressed edges meet; topstitch. Tie a bow, center at the bottom of yoke and hand stitch in place.

Shoulder Bag:

- 1. Fold shoulder bag with right sides together so that short edges meet; sew sides. Box bottom by bringing center bottom of bag to side seam (right sides together) and mark 3/4" from point. Stitch from edge to edge (Dia. D). Repeat for shoulder bag lining, but leave a 3" opening on one side for turning.
- 2. Fold shoulder bag band in half with wrong sides together, so that long edges meet; press. Open and press both long edges 1/4" to wrong side; fold in half again so that pressed edges meet; baste.
- 3. Pin shoulder bag band 4 1/2" up from one short edge of shoulder bag flap on the right side; topstitch close to band edges (Dia. E).
- 4. Fold flap with right sides together so that short edges meet; sew sides. Turn right side out; press and topstitch 1/4" from edges.
- 5. Center the flap on one side of the shoulder bag (right side) with cut edges even; pin and sew. (*Note: Place the side of the flap with the band toward the shoulder bag.*)
- 6. Fold strap in half lengthwise and press. Open and press long edges 1/4" to wrong side; fold so that pressed edges meet and topstitch. Then topstitch folded edge.
- 7. Center each end of the strap over a side seam on the right side of the bag with edges even; pin and sew.
- 8. Place lining inside shoulder bag with right sides together and top edges even; pin and sew. Turn right side out through opening in lining; hand stitch opening closed; press and topstitch close to top edge.
- 9. Place two small flowers with wrong sides together and topstitch 1/8" from edge. Repeat to create a large flower.
- 10. Cover a button following manufacturer's instructions. Layer a small flower on top of a large flower, center on top of the flap band and pin. Sew button to the center of the flowers, stitching through all layers.
- 11. Center cardboard bottom on wrong side of shoulder bag bottom. Wrap fabric over edges and glue. Place at bottom of shoulder bag.
