



No Sew Burp Cloths (5)

Finished Project Size: Approximately 14" x 19"

Supplies Needed

- 1 Bundle (5 - 18" x 21" pcs.)
- 5 Diapers (flat fold)
- 1/2 yd. Ultra Hold fusible web
- Fine-tip permanent marker (dark color recommended)
- Basic crafting supplies
- Iron and pressing surface

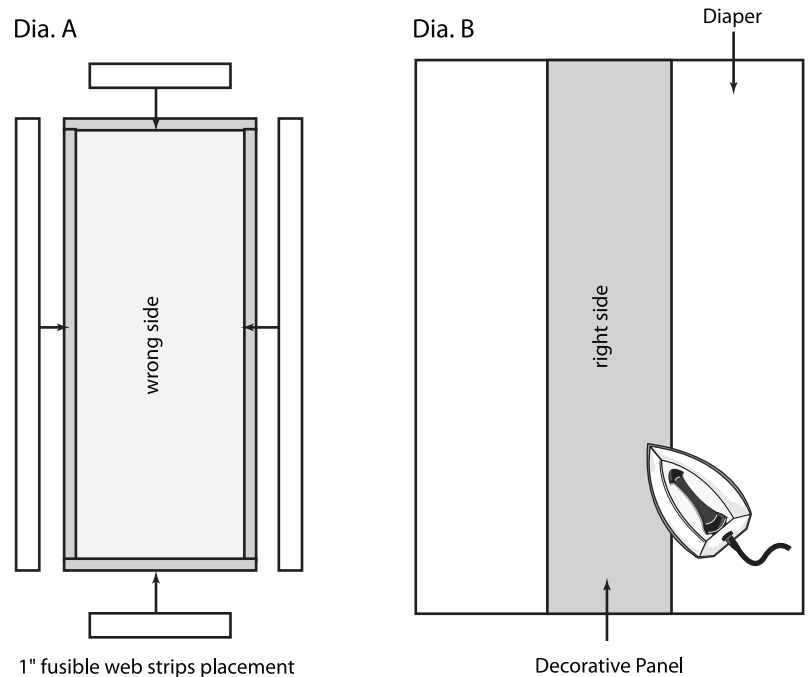
Instructions

Note: Pre-wash then iron fabrics and diapers before using.

Cutting (for each burp cloth)

Fabrics A-E: 1 – 6" x diaper length plus 1"
(decorative panel)

Fusible Web: 2 – 1" x diaper length
2 – 1" x 4"



Care instructions: Hand or machine wash, cold water, gentle cycle; line dry.



Constructing

1. On Fabric A panel, press all edges 1/2" to the wrong side.
2. Following manufacturer's instructions, apply the 1" fusible web strips to the wrong side of decorative panel close to the short folded edges and covering the raw edges (Dia. A). Remove paper backings. Repeat for the long folded edges.
3. Place the diaper right side up on the pressing surface, center the decorative panel right side up, and fuse in place (Dia. B). Repeat for remaining four diapers and panels. **Tip:** Place plain paper over and under burp cloth to protect iron and pressing surface when fusing.
4. Select fabric from the remaining bundle pieces for the bird and heart appliqués. **Optional:** Burp cloths can also be made using decorative panel only.
5. Place the fusible web paper side up on top of the bird and heart templates and trace each shape as listed. Cut out the shapes, leaving a small margin around the traced lines and fuse to the wrong side of the fabric. Cut out each appliqué along the drawn lines.
6. Remove paper backings. Position the appliqués as shown or as desired and fuse in place.

Finishing

7. Using the fine tip permanent marker, draw an eye on the bird and small stitching lines close to the raw edge of each appliqué. Refer to templates.
