



Pinwheel Wreath

Finished Project Size: 17" diameter

Supplies Needed

- 1 pkg. Charms (20 - 5" x 5" pcs.)
- 5/8 yd. HeatnBond® UltraHold fusible web
- 17" Grapevine wreath
- White spray paint
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- Coordinating buttons
- Rotary cutter, mat, and acrylic ruler
- Pinking shears or pinking rotary blade (optional)

Instructions

Before you begin: Do not pre-wash Charms. Read all instructions before beginning project.

Cutting

Fusible web: Cut 10 - 4 3/4" squares

Painting

Spray paint wreath and allow to dry.

Construction

1. Lay out Charms in ten pairs with right sides up. Turn one Charm of each pair wrong side up.
2. Following manufacturer's instructions, center and iron a fusible web square on the wrong side of one Charm from each pair. Let cool.

Care Instructions: Dust gently when needed.

3. Remove paper backings and lay remaining Charm of each pair right side up on Charm with fusible web, so that web is completely covered. Fuse Charms to make a double-sided square.

4. Trim each double-sided square to 4", pinking edges if desired.

5. Draw a 1 3/4" long diagonal line at each corner and cut on lines, pinking if desired (Dia. A).

6. Starting at the top edge of a square, fold down the upper left point to the center of the square (Dia. B). Glue point in place. Repeat with each point marked with an asterisk on the diagram to make a dimensional pinwheel (Dia. C). Make ten pinwheels.

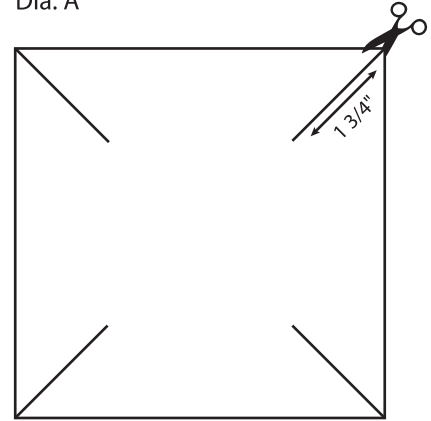
7. Arrange nine of the pinwheels in a circle. **Tip:** Use the remaining pinwheel as a package decoration or as desired.

8. Choose buttons for the centers. Buttons may be used singly or stacked and glued together for more dimension. Glue buttons or button stacks to the centers of each pinwheel.

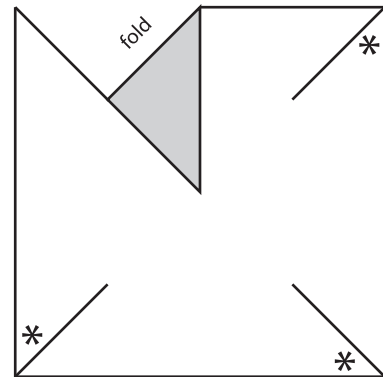
Finishing

9. Glue pinwheels to grapevine wreath as laid out. **Tip:** Use a hair dryer to remove glue "threads" from your project. Hang as desired.
