



# Project Instructions

## Appliqué Onesies® Infant Bodysuit

**Skill Level 2:**  
Some experience necessary  
**Approx. Crafting Time:**  
1 hour

## Supplies Needed

- 1 Land of Whimzie® Fabric Quarter
- 1 Gerber® Onesies® Infant Bodysuit
- Embroidery floss
- Sharp crewel needle
- Mechanical pencil or washout marker
- Pins
- Sharp, round-tipped scissors



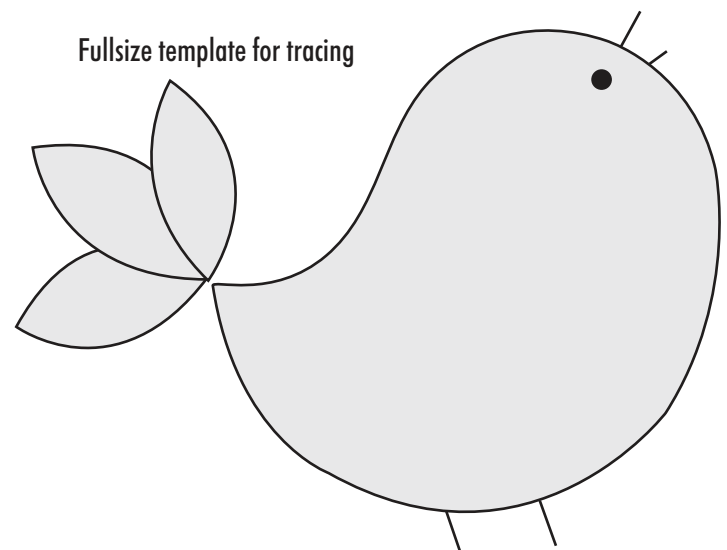
## Instructions

*Please read all instructions before you begin.*

### FOR BLOOMERS COLLECTION (APPLIQUÉ BIRD):

1. Place the bird motif (dia. a) inside the front of Onesies® and trace on the line. Mark beak, feet and tail feathers for embroidery.
2. Turn the Onesies® inside out. Cut out a 6" square of fabric. Pin the fabric square right side down, being sure it covers the bird motif drawing. Pin to hold in place. It may be helpful to insert a firm surface to keep from pinning into both layers.
3. Turn the Onesies® right side out.
4. Using 3 strands of embroidery thread, sew small running stitches on the drawn line around the motif, tail feathers, beak and feet. Tie the ends of the thread together to secure.
5. Start clipping away the Onesies® fabric from the fabric below it, inside the bird body only, about 1/8" - 1/4" inside the stitching, using sharp, round tipped scissors. Trim excess fabric inside about 1/4" outside of stitching line.
6. Stitch a French knot for the eye (optional).

**Care instructions:** Machine wash in cold water, gentle cycle; tumble dry low.

## Project Instructions Continued

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### FOR BABY SAFARI COLLECTION:

7. Choose a motif from the fat quarter. Draw around the motif with a circle or rectangle and cut out.
8. Turn the Onesies® inside out. Center the motif right side down, just below the front neckline (right side of motif to wrong side of Onesies®). Pin to hold in place. It may be helpful to insert a firm surface to keep from pinning into both layers.
9. Turn the Onesies® right side out.
10. Using 3 strands of embroidery thread, sew small running stitches around the motif. Tie the ends of the thread together to secure.
11. Turn Onesies® right side out. Start clipping away the Onesies® fabric from the motif below it, about  $\frac{1}{8}$ " –  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from stitching, using sharp, round tipped scissors.
