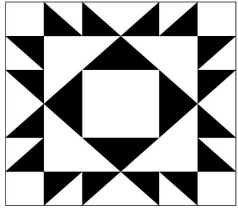

1800's CLUB

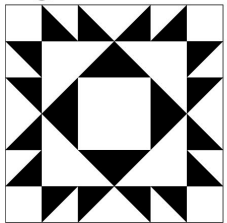
3rd Saturday of each month 10am-11am
