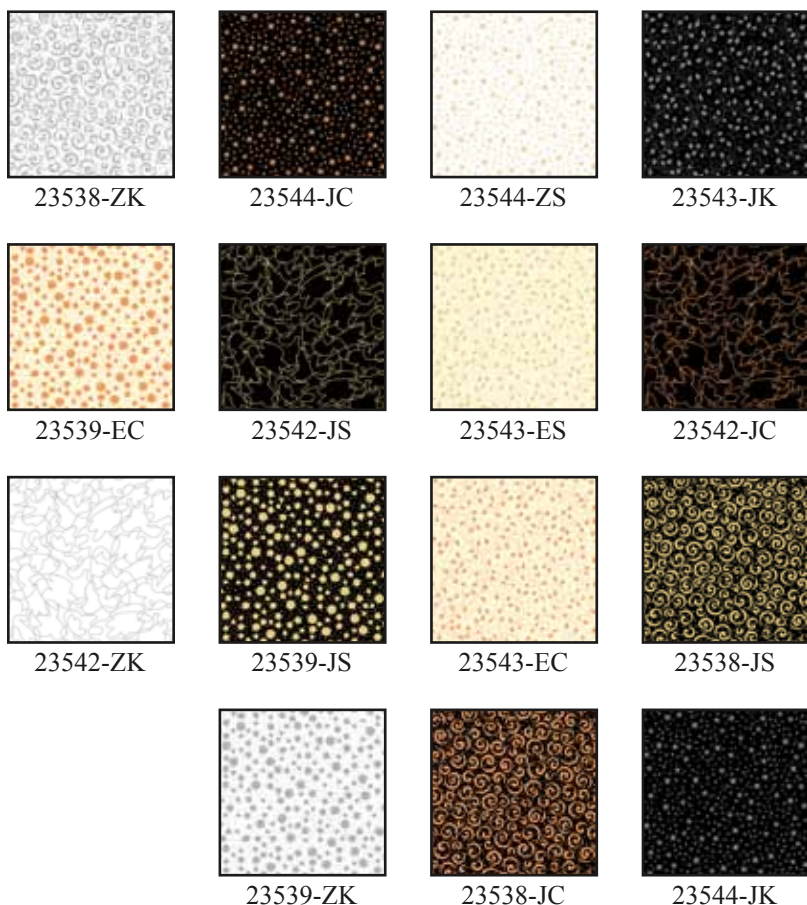

23544-JC	Fat ¼

23542-ZK	Fat ¼
23539-JS	Fat ¼

23539-ZK	Fat ¼
23538-JC	Fat ¼
23544-JK	1
Backing of choice = 3 ½ yards.	

Cutting

Pair the following sets of fat quarters with right sides together:

- A. 23538-ZK (White/Silver Curly Cue) and 23544-JC (Black/Copper Stars)
- B. 23544-ZS (White/Gold Stars) and 23543-JK (black/silver vine)
- C. 23539-EC (Cream/Copper Dots) and 23542-JS (Black/Gold Scribble)
- D. 23543-ES (Cream/Gold Leaf) and 23542-JC (Black/Copper Scribble)
- E. 23542-ZK (White/Silver Scribble) and 23539-JS (black/gold dots)
- F. 23543-EC (Cream/Copper Leaf) and 23538-JS (black/gold curly cue)
- G. 23539-ZK (White/Silver Dots) and 23538-JC (Black/Copper Curly Cue)

Note: The fat quarter of 23544-JK (Black/Silver Stars) is not used in the blocks.

From each set of fat quarters, cut (4) 7⁷/₈" squares. Cut each set of squares in half diagonally to yield a total of (8) half-square-triangle units per set.

23544-JK (Black/Silver Stars)

- Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sew together end to end with diagonal seams; press.
- Cut (2) 2" x 52¹/₂" and (2) 2" x 56¹/₂".
- Cut (6) 2¹/₂" strips for binding.

Metals Quilt

Construction

1. Sew each half-square-triangle unit together along the long edge to yield (8) H-S-T units of each set A-G. Press seams open. Make (56) units.

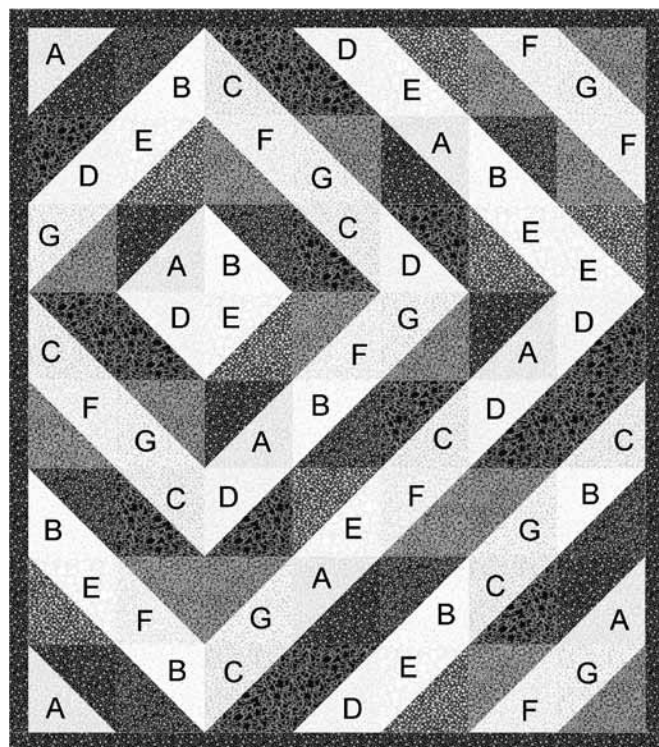

2. Refer to layout for placement of units A-G or place blocks into your preferred setting.



3. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams open.
4. Sew rows together matching triangle tips. Press seams open.
5. Sew a 2" x 56½" border strip to each side of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Sew a 2" x 52½" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

Finishing

1. Layer quilt top, batting and prepared backing. Quilt as desired.
2. Trim layers even with edges of quilt top.
3. Prepare binding and sew to quilt using your preferred method.
