I used my computer and printer to make my lettering have just the right size and font.

Prepare one sheet of freezer paper

- 1. Cut $8" \times 10 \times 1/2"$ piece fabric for the seed packet lettering.
- 2. Place the fabric on the ironing board with wrong side up.
- 3. Place a sheet of appliqué template paper centered on the fabric and iron to the fabric with a dry iron. Make sure to iron the freezer paper nice and flat with no wrinkles.
- 4. Place the fabric in you Inkjet print so the inking will be printed directly on the fabric.
- 5. Print the lettering on fabric sheet.

 DO NOT REMOVE THE FREEZER PAPER FROM THE FABRIC.
- 6. Carefully spray starch the fabric and iron dry (no steam). Repeat this step 3 times. This will help prevent the inking from bleeding in the next step.
- 7. Carefully ink over the lettering with a Black Pigma .005 pen and iron dry. Repeat this step about 3 times until the lettering is evenly inked.
- 8. Now your inked fabric can be removed and used to make the appliqué shapes.

** Note

I did not use a pretreated printable fabric sheet for my printed fabric. I have found that the printable fabric sheets are very hard to hand sew through.
