

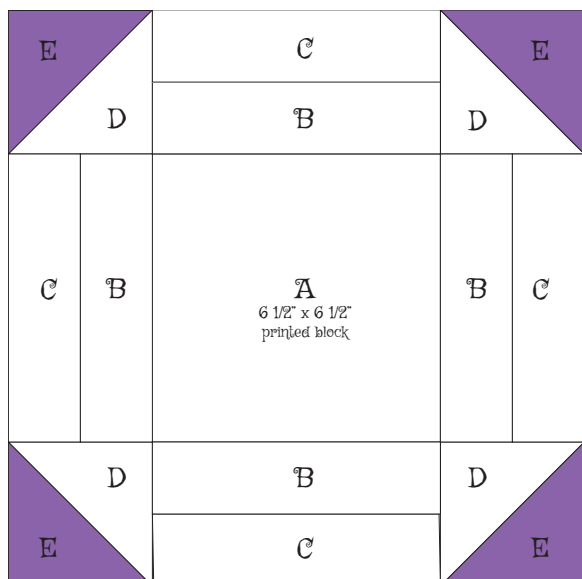

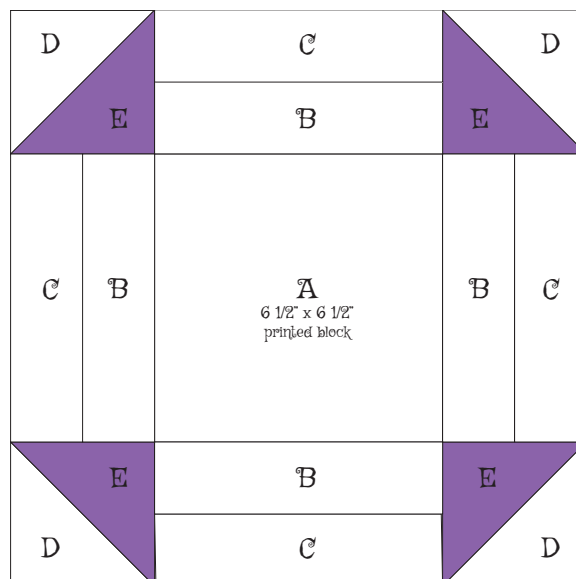

## Fabric Requirements

Finished Quilt Size 50" x 74"  
All seam allowances 1/4"



2 panels



2 yards  
Border



1 3/4 yards  
Background C & D



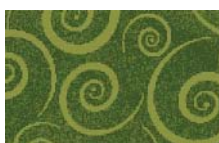
3/4 yards  
Binding

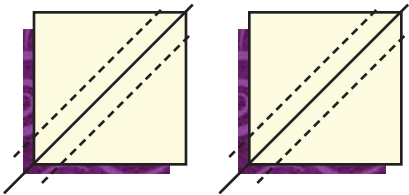
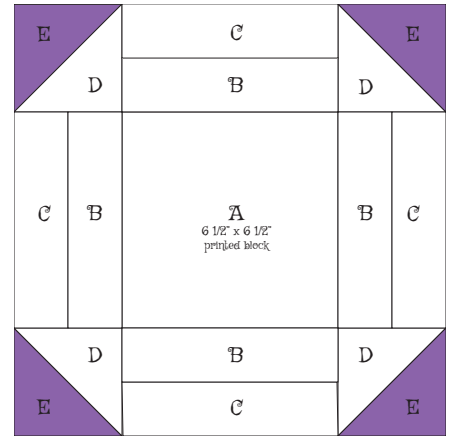

## Block 1 - Make 8

Instruction below are for making one block.

Finished block size 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

- From the printed panels cut:
  - 1 - center block 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"
  - 14 - small motif blocks 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"
- From Dark Purple & Light background fabrics:
  - Cut 2 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares
- Place dark and light fabrics right side together.
  - Draw a diagonal line on each light square .
  - Sew a 1/4" seam along each side of the pencil line.
  - Cut block apart on the pencil line.
  - Press seam open and square up each block to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"



make 4 half square triangle

- From light background fabric
  - Cut 4 - 2" x 6 1/2" for C strips



- From accent fabric
  - Cut 4 - 2" x 6 1/2" for B. strips



- Sew B. & C strips together. Press seams open.



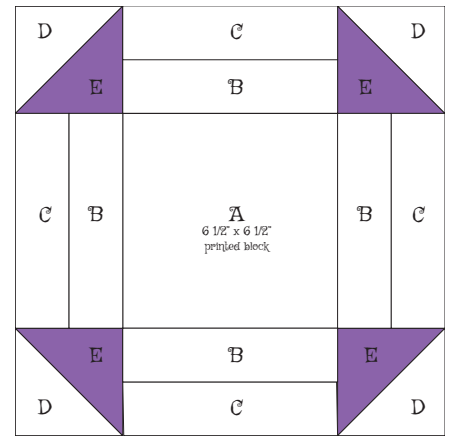
Make 4 B. & C units

- Sew block together with one 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" printed motif from the panel fabric.

**Make 8 assorted blocks.**  
**Use the color photo of color placement.**

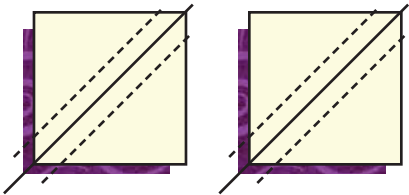


## Block 2 - Make 6



2. From Dark Purple & Light background fabrics:  
Cut 2 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares

3. Place dark and light fabrics right side together.  
Draw a diagonal line on each light square .  
Sew a 1/4" seam along each side of the pencil line.  
Cut block apart on the pencil line.  
Press seam open and square up each block to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" .



Make 4 half square triangle

4. From light background fabric  
Cut 4 - 2" x 6 1/2" for C strips



From accent fabric  
Cut 4 - 2" x 6 1/2" for B. strips



Make 4 B. & C units


5. Sew B. & C strips together. Press seams open.

6. Sew block together with one 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" printed motif from the panel fabric.

Make 6 assorted blocks.  
Use the color photo of color placement.



7. Sew 1 blocks and 1 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" center panel together in Horizontal rows.  
Use the color photo for placement.

8. Cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips from the Lt Purple.   
Sew short ends together. Cut 2 - strips 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" for top and bottom borders.  
Cut 2 - strips 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" for side borders.  
Sew 1 st border strips to quilt top. Press seam open.

9. From the Border print fabric:  
Cut 2 - 6 1/2" x 38 1/2" strips for top & bottom 2nd border strips.  
Sew the border strips to top & bottom of quilt. Use the photo for placement.



10. From the Border print fabric:  
Cut 2 - 6 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips for side 2nd border strips.



- From the Lt Purple fabric:  
Cut 4 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" corner squares from Lt purple fabric.



11. Sew the Lt Purple corner stone blocks on each end of the border strips. Press seams open. Sew border strips to sides of the quilt. Quilt should measure 50 1/2" x 74 1/2".

## Finishing

### Backing fabric Requirements

Horizontal seam - 3 1/4 yards

Vertical seam - 4 2/3 yards

1. Layer backing batting quilt top. Baste using your favorite method.
2. Quilt using your favorite method.
3. Cut 8 - 3" x width of fabric from the DK Purple fabric.  
Bind using your favorite method.
