

**Class Title:** *Carnival Flower Quiltworx Technique of the Month*

**Pattern:** *Carnival Flower Wall  
Carnival Flower Queen  
(Patterns must be purchased  
from the instructor.)*

**Skill Level:** *Experienced Beginner*

**Special Notions:** *12" & 18" Add A 1/4" ruler  
UHU Glue stick or similar washable glue stick (Elmer's)  
SewLine, Bohin, Fons & Porter or similar brand fabric glue pen & refills  
Microtex 70/10 or 75/11 sewing machine needles  
Flower head pins (I use the blue Clover flower head pins & yellow flower  
head pins)  
Purple Thang or Stiletto  
Scotch Tape  
Stapler and Staple Remover  
2 template plastic strips, 3" x 12" & 3" x 18"  
Zippered plastic bags, 1 gallon size or larger used to organize units; (I  
use the 2-1/2 gallon size)  
Large Paper Clips, about 50 (to help with organization) OR Jumbo  
Wonder Clips*

**Sewing Supplies:** *Sewing Machine and accessories including your book  
1/4" presser foot for sewing accurate 1/4" seams (a guided foot is not  
recommended)  
50 wt neutral or gray thread to blend with fabrics, such as Aurifil  
Scissors  
Straight pins  
Seam ripper  
6" x 24" Ruler or similar size*



60 mm Rotary Cutter with new blade  
Cutting Mat (not required if LQS has mats available)

### **Class Information:**

*Carnival Flower is the 7th Judy Niemeyer/Quiltworx Technique of the Month Paper Pieced Quilt published in January 2023. It uses many current paper piecing techniques developed by Quiltworx and introduces new processes and techniques. There are 7 classes for this quilt, each covering one or more groups in the quilt and new piecing techniques.*

*We will use Quiltster to color our quilts in the first class or finalize fabric choices. Please have an idea of the colors that you would like to use in your quilt. You do not need to bring your sewing machine for the first class. We will review the instruction booklets, review cutting papers, setting up fabric charts and organization. During class, you will learn the paper piecing technique and then go home to complete the units. The last class will be assembling the quilt top. The classes will be a month or so apart to allow plenty of time to complete the units prior to the next class.*

*A good rule of thumb is to purchase additional fabric in each color. I will generally round up fabric yardage to the next quarter yard. This is just in case you run short or for mistakes that can happen (and do!) while cutting or piecing. Save your scraps – you could possibly need them later.*

*You will need to purchase the pattern from me in the first session or before the first session. If you have any questions prior to class – please contact me before class.*
