size bags)

Large Paper Clips, about 50 (to help with organization)

Sewing Supplies: Sewing Machine and accessories including your book

1/4" foot for sewing accurate 1/4" seams (a guided foot is not recommended)

50 wt neutral or gray thread to blend with fabrics, such as Aurifil

Scissors

Straight pins

Seam ripper

6" x 24" Ruler

Cutting Mat (not required if your local quilt shop has mats for your use) &

60 mm Rotary Cutter with new blade

Class Information:

Star Baby is a good introductory class to paper piecing, Quiltworx' patterns, techniques and the Lonestar unit that is featured in many Quiltworx patterns. This is a 2-day class. You will not finish the quilt in class but will learn the skills needed to finish it at home. The pattern contains enough papers to make two Star Baby quilts.

I encourage you to use Quiltster to color your quilt. Quiltster is a color design subscription—based software (it is accessed via the internet) for coloring Quiltworx patterns. It is available from Quiltster.com for a nominal fee. If you decide not to subscribe to Quiltster, I can help you color your quilt using my copy of Quiltster. Please let me know if you would like me to help you with your colors. It will help if you have an idea of the colors that you would like to use in your quilt. Once you have colored your quilt, Quiltster will give you a yardage table to help with fabric purchases.

I encourage you to check for pattern corrections on the Quiltworx website www.quiltworx.com/corrections/. Each pattern has a print date on the back page.

Starbaby Class Instructions

Please have your papers cut before class. Place in the bag listed. Remember the fabric layout templates (TP) are cut on the outside dark line. The foundation sewing papers (NP) and T-Templates are cut 1/8" beyond the outside dark line.

Please have the following fabric cut before class. Place all in the bag listed.

Group A - Tiny Lonestar Unit SS

- ❖ You will need one 2-½" x WOF (42") strip of fabric for each diamond in the Lonestar. There are 9 diamonds in the Lonestar Unit.
- * See the line drawing on page 11 of the instruction booklet to help with coloring your Lonestar.
- Place all your strips in Bag A1.

Group A - Background and Optional Border

Fabric A1 Background

- Cut (2) 12-1/2" x WOF (42") strips of Background Fabric A1. Stack right sides up.
- Place in Bag A1.

Fabric B1 Border

- * Cut (4) 5" x WOF (42") strips of Border Fabric B1. Stack right sides up.
- · Place in Bag A1.
