

Class Title: *Any Quiltworx Technique of the Month*

Pattern: *Choose from Wall or Queen of the following Quiltworx TOM:*

Dinner Plate Dahlia

Glacier Star

Mariner's Compass

Paradise in Bloom

Vintage Rose

(Patterns must be purchased from the instructor.)

Skill Level: *Experienced Beginner*

Instructor: *Susan Sears*

Special Notions: *12" & 18" Add A 1/4" ruler
UHU Glue stick or similar washable glue stick (Elmer's)
SewLine, Bohin, Fons & Porter or similar brand fabric glue pen & refills
Microtex 70/10 needles
Flower head pins (I use the blue Clover flower head pins & yellow flower head pins)
Purple Thang or Stiletto
Scotch Tape
Stapler and Staple Remover
2 template plastic strips, 3" x 12" & 3" x 18"
Zippered plastic bags, 1 gallon size or larger used to organize units; (I use & like the 2-1/2 gallon size)
Large Paper Clips, about 50 (to help with organization)*

Sewing Supplies: *Sewing Machine and accessories including your book
1/4" foot for sewing accurate 1/4" seams (a guided foot is not recommended)
50 wt neutral or gray thread to blend with fabrics, such as Aurifil
Scissors
Straight pins
Seam ripper*

6" x 24" Ruler

Cutting Mat (not required since Lyons Quilting has mats for each table)
& 60 mm Rotary Cutter with new blade

Class Information:

Any Quiltworx Technique of the Month can be used for this class. There will be 7 classes for this class. You will work at your own pace. If you are doing one of the TOM's, I can provide cutting instructions for them once I know which one you are doing.

You can use Quiltster to color your quilt in the first class or finalize fabric choices. Please have an idea of the colors that you would like to use in your quilt. You do not need to bring your sewing machine for the first class. Unfortunately, Quiltworx has not added Paradise in Bloom to Quiltster at this time. I can help you with fabric choices if you are doing the Paradise in Bloom. We will review cutting papers and organization in the first class. We will start sewing units in March. The last class will be assembly. TOM

You will need to purchase the pattern from me in the first session or before the first session. If you have any questions prior to class – please contact me before class.
