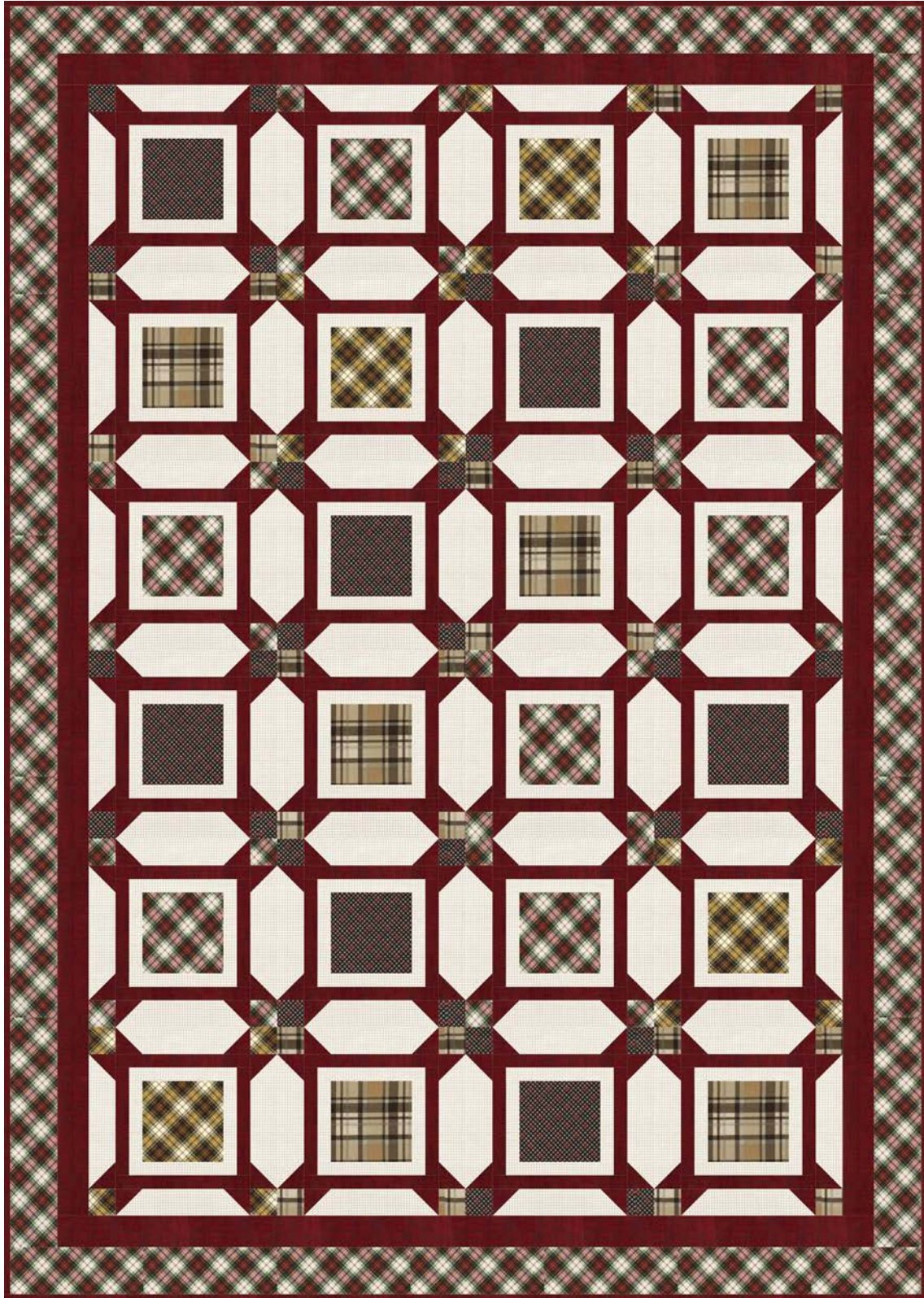

Fabric Requirements

$\frac{3}{8}$ yard Tailor-CF5321 Natural
 $\frac{3}{8}$ yard Tailor-CF5327 Red
 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard Tailor-CF5334 Brown
 $1\frac{1}{8}$ yards Tailor-CF5334 Red
 $2\frac{1}{4}$ yards Tailor-CF7972 Cream
 $2\frac{5}{8}$ yards Tailor-CF7977 Red (includes binding)
 $5\frac{1}{8}$ yards Tailor backing fabric of your choice
 $67'' \times 92''$ batting

Cutting

From Tailor-CF5321 Natural:

- Cut one $5\frac{5}{8}''$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut six $5\frac{5}{8}''$ squares.
- Cut two $2\frac{1}{4}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-four $2\frac{1}{4}''$ squares.

From Tailor-CF5327 Red:

- Cut one $5\frac{5}{8}''$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut seven $5\frac{5}{8}''$ squares.
- Cut two $2\frac{1}{4}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-eight $2\frac{1}{4}''$ squares.

From Tailor-CF5334 Brown:

- Cut one $5\frac{5}{8}''$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut four $5\frac{5}{8}''$ squares.
- Cut one $2\frac{1}{4}''$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut sixteen $2\frac{1}{4}''$ squares.

From Tailor-CF5334 Red:

- Cut eight $3\frac{1}{2}''$ x WOF strips for outer border.
- Cut one $5\frac{5}{8}''$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut seven $5\frac{5}{8}''$ squares.
- Cut two $2\frac{1}{4}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty-eight $2\frac{1}{4}''$ squares.

From Tailor-CF7972 Cream:

- Cut two $7\frac{3}{8}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight $7\frac{3}{8}'' \times 1\frac{3}{8}''$ strips.
- Cut two $5\frac{5}{8}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight $5\frac{5}{8}'' \times 1\frac{3}{8}''$ strips.
- Cut six $5\frac{5}{8}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut ninety-six $5\frac{5}{8}'' \times 2\frac{1}{4}''$ strips.
- Cut seven $2\frac{5}{8}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut ninety-six $2\frac{5}{8}''$ squares.

From Tailor-CF7977 Red:

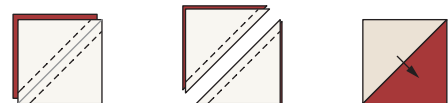
- Cut fifteen $2\frac{1}{2}''$ x WOF strips for inner border and binding.
- Cut two $7\frac{3}{8}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight $7\frac{3}{8}'' \times 1\frac{3}{8}''$ strips.
- Cut two $9\frac{1}{8}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty-eight $9\frac{1}{8}'' \times 1\frac{3}{8}''$ strips.
- Cut seven $2\frac{5}{8}''$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut ninety-six $2\frac{5}{8}''$ squares.

Block Construction

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}''$ unless otherwise noted and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press after each addition.

1. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on the wrong side of all the $2\frac{5}{8}''$ CF7972 Cream squares. Pair the marked squares with the $2\frac{5}{8}''$ CF7977 Red squares, right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the marked line, open the triangles and press the seam toward the darker fabric (figure 1). Make 192 half-square triangle units (HST).

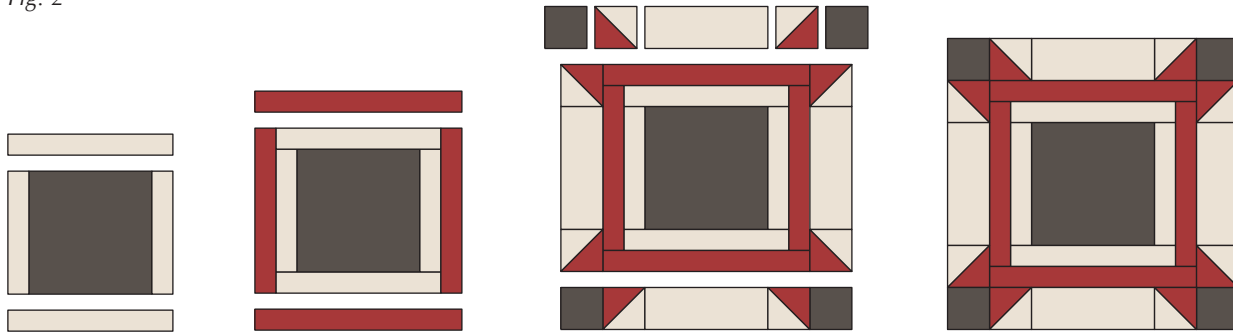


HST Unit

2. Assemble the block according to Figure 2. Sew one $5\frac{5}{8}'' \times 1\frac{3}{8}''$ CF7972 Cream strip to each side of a $5\frac{5}{8}''$ feature print square. Sew one $7\frac{3}{8}'' \times 1\frac{3}{8}''$ CF7972 Cream rectangle to top and bottom of the center square.
3. Repeat step 2 using a $7\frac{3}{8}'' \times 1\frac{3}{8}''$ CF7977 Red strip for each side and a $9\frac{1}{8}'' \times 1\frac{3}{8}''$ CF7977 Red strip for the top and bottom.

4. Noting the orientation, sew one HST to each end of the $5\frac{5}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{4}$ " CF7972 Cream strips. Sew one strip to each side of the block.
5. Sew a $2\frac{1}{4}$ " feature print square to each end of the remaining step 4 units. Sew one pieced strip to the top and another to the bottom of the block. Make a total of twenty-four blocks with the following feature print centers:

Make four: CF5334 Brown

Make six: CF5321 Natural

Make seven *each*: CF5327 Red and CF5334 Red

Finishing

10. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
11. Stitch the remaining $2\frac{1}{2}$ " CF7977 Red binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
11. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

Quilt Top Assembly

6. Following the quilt photo, lay out six rows of four blocks each. Stitch the blocks together in each row. Press seams in alternate directions for adjacent rows.
7. Sew the rows together in order, matching adjacent seams.
8. For the inner border, sew seven $2\frac{1}{2}$ " CF7977 Red strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Stitch a border strip to each side of the quilt center and trim the extra length. Press seams toward the border. In the same manner, stitch one border to the top and another to the bottom.
9. For the outer border, sew eight $3\frac{1}{2}$ " CF5334 Red strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Stitch a border strip to each side of the quilt center and trim the extra length. Press seams toward the border. In the same manner, stitch one border to the top and another to the bottom.

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
