

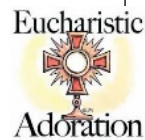

We once again celebrate this season of growth & grace. **Lent is a yearly renewal of our ideals as followers of Jesus.** We pick ourselves up, dust ourselves off, and strive to be people of greater Faith, Hope, and Love. The high point of our Lenten activities is the renewal of our Baptismal Promises at mass on Easter. As you prepare for Lent, ask yourself:

How will you **PRAY** better?
 How will you be more **GENEROUS**?

What must you **GIVE UP** in order to give more of yourself to God?

A reminder: the law of the Church requires those 18-59 years old **TO FAST** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and those age 14 and up **TO ABSTAIN** from meat on the Fridays of Lent (beef, pork, poultry & eggs, etc.). Of course that is waived if a person has a health condition, but they could do some other act of penance in its place.

Remember, every Catholic is obligated to go to CONFESSION at least once a year.

The best way to prepare ourselves for Easter is by celebrating Reconciliation. If it has been awhile, make that your most important Lenten Resolution.

From the 2019 Lenten Message of Pope Francis

Dear brothers and sisters,
 The lenten period of forty days spent by the Son of God in the desert of creation had the goal of making it once more that garden of communion with God that it was before original sin (cf. Mk1:12-13; Is 51:3).



May our Lent this year be a journey along that same path, bringing the hope of Christ also to creation, so that it may be "set free from its bondage to decay and obtain the glorious liberty of the children of God" (Rom 8:21).

Let us not allow this season of grace to pass in vain!

Let us ask God to help us set out on a path of true conversion. Let us leave behind our selfishness and self-absorption, and turn to Jesus' Passover. Let us stand beside our brothers and sisters in need, sharing our spiritual and material goods with them.

In this way, by concretely welcoming Christ's victory over sin and death into our lives, we will also radiate its transforming power to all of creation.
