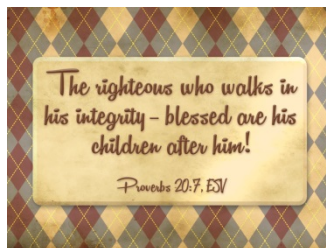

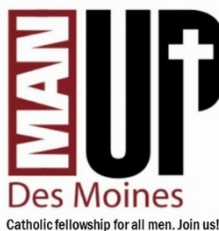

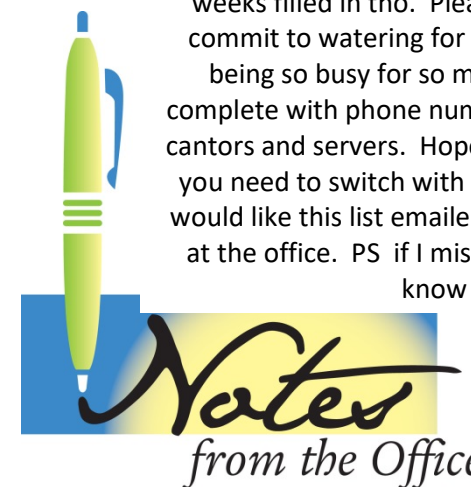

## Elements of Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus



-The 12 Promises to St. Margaret Mary

-The Image of the Sacred Heart, particularly when honored in the home

-Communion on 9 First Fridays

*“I promise you, in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the first Friday for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance; they shall not die in my disgrace nor without receiving the sacraments; my divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in that last moment.” — Our Lord to St. Margaret Mary*

-The Feast of the Sacred Heart on the Friday after Corpus Christi

On the Feast of the Sacred Heart itself, we can gain a plenary indulgence by making an Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart.

-Eucharistic Adoration, accompanying Our Lord remembering when he was abandoned in Gethsemane

-Reparation, acts of love to make up for the offenses against Jesus and the Blessed Sacrament

-Consecration to the Sacred Heart

# **CORPUS CHRISTI AND THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS-**

## **Connecting the Blessed Sacrament and the Love of Christ**

Within the space of a less than a week, the Church celebrated two major feast days. The first was **the Feast of Corpus Christi** (“The Body and Blood of Christ”) and the second was **the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus**. When one examines the theological implications of these feast days, one sees **deep connections between the two**.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Christ traces back to St. Mary Margaret, a 17th-century French Catholic nun and mystic. One day when she was 24 years old she was returning home from a ball wearing a lovely dress. She had a vision of Christ when He was scourged. That inspired her to enter the Visitation Convent in Paray, France in 1671. The next year In one of the first Sacred Heart apparitions, **Jesus told her how He wanted to make known to the world the great treasures of His love**, namely His desire for the salvation and sanctification of mankind. He then made known **His desire for a feast day dedicated to His Sacred Heart to be celebrated during the week following the Feast of Corpus Christi**.

**So much does He love us that Christ gave Himself to us** in and through His life, ministry, death and resurrection. **This self-giving love of Christ towards man is extended to us through the sacraments**. We see this in the Eucharist in particular. The **Eucharist** is the unbloody renewal or perpetuation of Christ's sacrifice on the Cross. **It is a participation in that perfect sacrifice of love which took place on the Cross**.

**The Eucharist, as an expression of God’s love**, helps us to attain – and in fact is a form of – union between us and God. This helps us to live less for ourselves and more for God. We overcome being in a state of sin and attain a state of grace- of moral and spiritual purity. **This is the effect of God’s love; this is also the effect of receiving the Blessed Sacrament**.

Other eucharistic elements of devotion to the Sacred Heart are the practices of communion on **9 First Fridays** and Holy Hours of **Eucharistic Adoration** in reparation for the indifference and profanities suffered by Our Lord hidden in the Eucharist out of love for us.

Our Lord knew very well what He was doing in asking for the feast day dedicated to His Sacred Heart to be celebrated so closely to the feast day dedicated to the Blessed Sacrament.
