Religious Freedom Week
June 22-29, 2018

"(Religious) freedom remains one of America's most precious possessions. And as my brothers the United States Bishops have reminded us, all are called to be vigilant, precisely as good citizens, to preserve and defend that freedom from everything that would threaten or compromise it." *** Pope Francis

People of faith are committed to serving others in God's love in healthcare, child welfare, migration and refugee resettlement, education, and more. Religious freedom protects the space in which we can continue to serve.

Religious Freedom Week begins June 22 with the Feast of Saints Thomas More and John Fisher who proclaimed that loyalty to Christ's Catholic Church is above loyalty to King Henry. During this week we also celebrate the Feast of the Birth of John The Baptist who proclaimed that loyalty to God's commandments, especially concerning marriage, is more important than obedience to King Herod. It concludes on June 29 with the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul who proclaimed that loyalty to Christ is superior to loyalty to Caesar.

With the court system being used to advance a secular and atheistic worldview and step by step marginalizing the traditional religious worldview, we are reminded that rights that are not defended are easily lost. Let us not be the generation to squander what our ancestors have built up.
