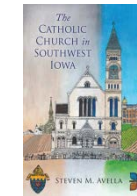

St. Kateri Tekakwitha - a Native American saint - Feast Day of July 14

St. Kateri Tekakwitha is the first Native American to be recognized as a saint by the Catholic Church. She was born in 1656, in the Mohawk village of Ossernenon. Her mother was an Algonquin, who was captured by the Mohawks and who took a Mohawk chief for her husband. She contracted smallpox as a four-year-old child which scarred her skin. The scars were a source of humiliation in her youth. Worse, her entire family died during the outbreak.

Kateri Tekakwitha was subsequently raised by her uncle, who was the chief of a Mohawk clan. Kateri was known as a skilled worker, who was diligent and patient.

At age 19, Kateri Tekakwitha converted to Catholicism, taking a vow of chastity and pledging to marry only Jesus Christ. Her decision was very unpopular with her adoptive parents and their neighbors. Some of her neighbors started rumors of sorcery. To avoid persecution, she traveled to a Christian native community south of Montreal. She often prayed for the conversion of her fellow Mohawks. Kateri was very devout and was known for her steadfast devotion. She was also very sickly. Sadly, just five years after her conversion to Catholicism, she became ill and passed away at age 24, on April 17, 1680.



Her name, Kateri, is the Mohawk form of Catherine, which she took from St. Catherine of Siena. St. Kateri Tekakwitha was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on Oct. 21, 2012. She is the patroness of ecology and the environment, people in exile and Native Americans.

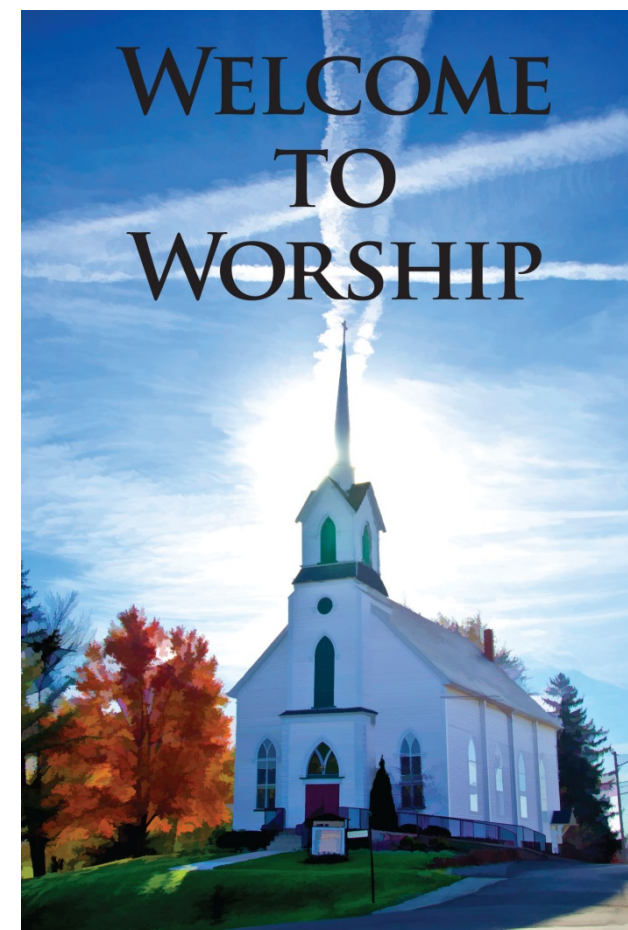

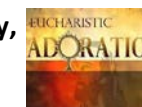
May our new bishop fill our minds and hearts with the truth of the Gospel, the power of the Sacraments, and the desire to build up Your holy Church.
