Accordion Clutch Wallet Supplies

This Accordion Clutch Wallet can be made using 5 fat Quarters for a scrappy look or with larger amounts of fewer fabrics. The interior has 2 zipper pockets and a card holder. A strap could be added if desired. The finished size is approximately 10-1/2" x 4"

REQUIRED PATTERN:

Accordion Clutch Wallet by Susie Meyers of Paisley Duck Quilting and Design

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

6 Fat Quarters (the 6th one is for the zipper pockets lining) or the following:

Outer Shell and Lining - 2 EACH at least 20" x 20"

Card Holder - 2 EACH at least 10" x 20" **AND** 1 EACH at least 10" x 13" Zipper Pouches -

Outer - 2 EACH at least 10" x 13"

Lining - 2 EACH at least 10" x 13"

Zipper Tabs - 1 EACH at least 4" x 10"

NOTE: We will trim these to exact sizes in class.

Zippers:

2 Zippers each at least 9" long (do **NOT** use invisible zippers)

Snap:

1 Magnetic Snap (I like the 1/2" size) **OR a sew in snap**

Batting and Interfacing:

1/2 Yard of Fusible Fleece, Pellon 987F1 Yard Shape Flex, Pellon SF101

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter and Your Favorite Ruler

Regular Sewing Thread in Neutral Shade to Blend with Fabric (I like Aurifil)

NOTE: There will be opportunity to do topstitching if you wish to use thread to compliment or contrast with your fabrics. You may wish to quilt the main fabric with the batting and lining.

New Needles (80/12 Microtex Sharp are my favorites)
Hera Marker, Wooden Iron, Bone Folder, Point Turner (optional but very helpful)
Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork Pins)
Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)
Fabric Marker (I like the Sew Line ones)
1/4" Piecing Foot **OR** the foot you use to achieve this

Zipper Foot Walking Foot if you are wanting to quilt the main wallet and lining Sewing Machine in Good Working Order Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual
