

# Beginning Paper Piecing

Whether you've thought about foundation paper piecing, but didn't know where to start, or you've never heard of it and want to find out what it is, or you're not sure if it's for you, join us for this class and find out. We'll show you some of the basic skills you'll need to get started.

**MATERIALS FEE:** \$10.00 payable to the Instructor in class for pre-printed paper piecing templates.

**RECOMMENDED RULER:**

Add-A-Quarter Plus in either the 6" or 12" size

**NOTE:** If you have the old style Add-A-Quarter Ruler that is fine.

**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:**

8x8 or larger scraps or several coordinating fat quarters.

**GENERAL SUPPLIES:**

Rotary Cutter

Rulers, 6" x 24" Recommended **OR** Your Favorite

Thread in Neutral Shade for Piecing and Construction (Aurifil is my favorite)

New Needle, Size 80/12 Sharp (recommended) **OR** Your Favorite

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork ones)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Hera Marker (optional) a Wooden Iron or Bone Folder will also work

1/4" Foot (seam allowances on this project are 1/4")

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual
