In this workshop you will have fun putting these straight lines and curves together to create this original block and quilt. Looks difficult but once you learn the construction and how easy the curves come together the quilt goes smoothly and easily creating a one of a kind keepsake. Join us for a day of tips, tricks and lots of fun.

MATERIALS LIST

Quilt Size: 48" X 64" 12 Blocks 16" Blocks 3 Blocks Wide X 4 Blocks Long

Fabric Requirements:

The following are the yardage requirements you will need. Next to the requirements in parenthesis are the colors I used for each of the pieces in the block. Following page is a copy of the block.

Piece A : 5/8 yard (Navy with color flecks)parenthesis
Piece B: 1 yard (Bright Pink)
Piece C: 2 ¼ yards (Flowered Print)
Piece D: 1 ½ yards (Green)
Piece A: 5/8 yard (Turquoise)

The entire pattern will be given to you in the workshop. The pattern is cut a little different than most patterns. You do not need to cut anything out before coming to class. Bring your fabric and be ready to cut and sew.

SUPPLIES

- Thread to match your fabrics or a nice neutral thread such as a light gray or beige.
- Sharp Fabric scissors
- Small 45 degree rotary cutter (or you can use scissors)
- Small Mat (optional) we have mats at the store you can use.
- Pins
- Sewing Machine
- Foot Pedal
- Sewing machine manual (if you think you might need it or have a new or unfamiliar machine).
- Small Iron and pressing mat (optional)
- Any other supplies you might need or like to use.
