Beginning Quilting Wednesday 1:00-4:00 Victoria Jones Oct 8, 15, 22, 29, Nov 5, \$175 12, 19, Dec 3

This seven session class covers the basics of quilting from what tools and how to use them, picking fabrics, creating seven different blocks, adding borders, creating your quilt sandwich, and basic quilting techniques

Cherry Stones Friday 10:30-4:30 Victoria Jones October 10 \$45

A great table runner, bed runner, or wall hanging; this project goes together very quickly and is perfect for using your stash. You can make it scrappy or not - your choice! The pattern finished at 16-1/2" x 72" or you could make it any size by changing the number of units in your design. My design is 17" x 54" finished.

Pockets to Go Saturday 10:30-4:30 Victoria Jones October 11 \$45

Use this handy organizer next to your sewing machine, on your desk, or in the bathroom to keep everything at your fingertips. Pop the long organizer into a purse or tote bag, and you're ready to go. There are two sizes included in the pattern: Cube -6" wide x 6" long x 5" high; Long: 12" wide x 4" deep x 5-1/2" high. There are two outside zipper (easy to insert) pockets and many inside pockets in addition to empty space in the center of the organizer.

Decorative Christmas wreaths are usually made of evergreen leaves, holly, mistletoe...and don't forget fabric even better. In this workshop, we will be creating a holiday quilt using a variety of rich and dramatic green and red fabrics. The ribbon border adds a wonderful touch to this quilt. Lots of tips and tricks for perfect piecing. Join us for a fun, informative, festive day to create your unique Christmas quilt.

Learn to make this fun pumpkins quilt in three different sizes. 10" Square friendly. Hocus Pocus has rows of patchwork pumpkins in different sizes. Finished size 52" by 65.5".

My sample is different from the actual pattern.

This class is designed as a lecture format. Victoria will share information on how to improve your cutting, pressing, and piecing techniques. This is designed to share ways you may have already known and forgotten or never heard before to make your stitching better and more accurate.

Rope Baskets & Bowls Friday 10:30-4:30 Victoria Jones November 7 \$45

In this popular class you'll learn how much fun it is to make unique baskets, bowls, bags, and mats from your stash and cotton clothesline. The technique is so easy and quick you'll be amazed! In class we will be creating a small project so you will become familiar with several different techniques and then you'll be able to create your own project with confidence.

Hot & Heavy Iron Caddy Saturday 10:30-4:30 Victoria Jones November 8 \$45

This tote will hold your iron when you travel and when you're ready to iron open the tote and it becomes a convenient pressing surface. Now, when you're ready to go home from your class or retreat you can place the hot iron on the pressing surface, fold up the sides of the pressing surface, fasten the sides, and you are protected from the hot iron.

This book is truly an inspiration – so many quilts I wish to make from it. You get to choose the project that best suits your needs; with a few exceptions the techniques are the same for all the quilts. I've made at least four of these and had fun with each of them.

It's time to hop aboard the Monorail Quilt Pattern. Gather fabulous fat quarters in a cherished colorway or collection to stitch together this terrific transport to help you avoid traffic jams and red lights.

The Bitsy Box is a teeny tiny fabric box. Great little pouch for sewing notions, knitting notions, ear buds, cell phone chargers, baby binky's, kids toys etc.

Intro to Paper Piecing Marcie Walsh

Whether you've thought about foundation paper pricing, but didn't know where to start, or you've never heard of it and want to find out what it is, or you're not sure if it's for you, join us for this class and find out. We'll show you some of the basic skills you'll need to get started. You'll be precision piecing like a pro with this paper piecing skill builder class.

Nest Collage Victoria Jones Wednesday December 17 10:30-5:30 \$45

Whatevers! are 8" x 8" collage blocks that you can turn into runners, potholders, tiny quilts or continue making the designs for a larger collage quilt! If you have ever wanted to do one of Laura Heine's collage Quilts this is the perfect class to 'get your feet wet' and try the process on a small, simpler design.

Landscape/Seascape Design Victoria Jones

I have had a lot of fun with this technique- The curves were VERY easy to do and quite freeing- no matching of seams! I also enjoyed using different yarns and decorative threads during the creative process.

Piping and Flanges Techniques Victoria Jones

You will be making practice samples of corded piping and flanges for use as embellishment in your projects. We'll also discuss creating the piping from bias strips and practice techniques for creating truly square corners. In addition, we'll make a few covered buttons – a great way to spark up a shirt, bag, or tote.

Mondo / Midi Bag Friday 10:30-4:30 Victoria Jones December 26 \$45

These 'catch-all' bags are great for the beach, overnight trips, or toting you fabric stash to class or retreat. The Mondo bag is 'huge' while the Midi Bag is approximately half the size. This is a great place to use Charm Packs, the 2-1/2" square Candies, or your scraps. Both bags are made using 2-1/2" squares and a pre-printed fusible interfacing (included in the pattern) to make stitching all the seams EASY!! (I promise). So fun and easy you won't want to make just one!

Embellish Your Project

This is a technique class and you will try many different methods of adding interesting embellishment to your projects. You will learn to make piping, flanges, prairie points, covered buttons, and easy gathering. I will also demonstrate how to add magnetic snaps to bags. Longview is a fun free-form project inspired by busy congested city streets and tall buildings. Instructions will guide you through the process (and Victoria will help you) to piece 16 large window blocks that are then arranged into a foundation or grid. Using a free-form approach and, being as simple or complex as you like, make custom blocks to fill in the remaining space to create your own view. The finished size is 53" x 74".

Facing Your Quilt

Does your quilt appear to not need a traditional binding? Learn how to add a facing on your quilt rather than adding the traditional binding to the outer edge. Many art quilts are finished this way as adding a binding can distract from the 'look' you are wanting. This is a technique class so you will be creating a sample for use later on your 'real' quilt.

Baby Steps Saturday 10:30-4:30 Victoria Jones January 17 \$45

Baby Steps is a modified Original Beach Crawl for special little folks (or a great wall hanging). The blocks have been resized down to 4" size for a perfect smaller sized quilt. Using simple, fail proof curves for the waves, Easy fusible appliqued turtles, and a selection of fabrics, you're ready to join the beach crawl.

Fusible Applique Techniques

Complex looking appliqué is fast and easy using fusible appliqué methods. You'll learn about the methods and materials that make this technique a favorite medium for quilters of all levels!

Choose fabric in three different values; light, medium and dark. The trick is to make sure your light fabric IS light and cannot be mistaken for a medium or dark value. Make sure your medium fabric IS medium and cannot be mistaken for a light or dark, and the same goes for the dark. I chose to use a mix of fabrics as listed in the yardage requirements however, you can choose just three different fabrics, one light, one medium and one dark.

CLASSROOM POLICIES

- Please do not show up more than 30 minutes before class. We need time to prepare the classroom and/or wrap up the previous class.
