

Continuous Binding Techniques Supplies

Learn the secrets of perfect double fold continuous binding in this hands-on workshop, easily pieced, smooth, and flat with crisply creased corners - a fitting finish to your quilt. You will learn how to put binding on a 'normal' square corner quilt **AND** how to work with corners that are at an 'odd' angle, i.e., table runners with the 'pointy' ends.

Rotary Cutter and Your Favorite Small Ruler
Regular Sewing Thread in Neutral Shade (I like Aurifil)
New Needles (80/12 Microtex Sharp are my favorites)
14-In-1 Measuring Gauge **OR** Your Favorite Measuring Gauge
Hera Marker, Wooden Iron, Bone Folder, Point Turner (optional but very helpful)
Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork Pins)
Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)
Fabric Marker (I like the Sew Line ones)
Walking Foot (optional but highly recommended)
Sewing Machine in Good Working Order
Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual
