

Crimson Christmas Supplies

Give your Christmas decor the wow factor with these oversized poinsettia blooms. The asymmetrical design gives a contemporary nod while the depth and richness of color bring an elegance to any space. This quilt is constructed using a variety of shapes and sizes all cut using the original Creative Grids 60-Degree Diamond Ruler. The piecing starts smaller in the middle and “blooms” out bigger with each row of petals. There is no fussy piecing or Y seams involved! The finished quilt size is 52-1/2 x 56-1/2.

RECOMMENDED RULER: Highly Recommended
Creative Grids Non-Slip Large 60-Degree Diamond Ruler by Krista Moser
(CGR60DIA)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Kits for this project are available at Just For Fun Quilting.

1/4 Yard Each of Two Different Light Reds

1/4 Yard of One Medium Red

1/6 Yard of a Second Medium Red

1/3 Yard Each of Two Different Dark Reds

1/8 Yard of One Light Mauve

1/4 Yard of a Second Light Mauve

1/4 Yard Each of Two Different Medium Mauves

1/4 Yard Each of Two Different Dark Mauves

1/3 Yard of White

1/3 Yard of Creamy White

1/4 Yard of Grayish White

1/3 Yard of Second Grayish White

1/6 Yard of Tannish White

1/8 Yard of a Second Tannish White

1/4 Yard Each of Four Different Leaf Greens (Three Medium, One Dark)

1-1/2 Yards of Black for Background and Binding

3-1/4 Yards of Backing

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter (Small Mat Could Be Helpful)

Rulers, 6" x 24" Recommended **OR** Your Favorite

Small Iron and Pressing Surface Helpful

Thread in Neutral Shade for Piecing and Construction (Aurifil is my favorite)

New Needle, Size 80/12 Microtex Sharp (recommended) **OR** Your Favorite

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork ones)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Hera Marker (optional) a Wooden Iron or Bone Folder will also work

1/4" Foot or Foot you use to achieve it (seam allowances on this project are 1/4")

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual

PREPARATION FOR CLASS:

I would recommend identifying **EACH** fabric with the color from the fabric requirements list as several will be very similar to each other. Cut straps salvage to salvage (WOF) to the widths shown on Pages 2 and 3 of the pattern. Wait to cut further until class. All the remaining cutting will be done with the Creative Grids 60-Degree Diamond Ruler.
