

# Debonair Dragon - Supply List

Deceptively easy to make! Step-by-step bite-sized instructions accompanied by photos make this a comprehensive and easy-to-follow project with plenty of options to personalize it.

This can be made with minky, faux fur, quality cotton, fleece and repurposed fabrics, etc.



## Fabric Requirements:

- 2/3 yard minky for the body (you can also use fleece or faux fur if you have worked with it before).
- 8"x8" minky for: horns, foot pads, and claws (total 3 pieces)
- 22"x22" for belly
- 12"x20" for spikes
- 8"x45" batting for ears, wings, and spike support
- 20oz fiber fill stuffing
- 30mm safety eyes (instructor will have some to share)

**The instructor will have some minky scraps available for purchase for the accent parts of the dragon.** Please make sure to buy your body minky and interfacing/batting from the store.

## Other tools and supplies:

- Thread snips
- Thread to match your fabrics
- Fabric Scissors
- Pre-wound bobbins (or wind your own)
- Machine needles size 90/14 (Universal or ballpoint. NO MICROTEx)
- Sewing clips (Highly recommended, but straight pins or fork pins work)
- Sewing machine capable of straight stitching with power chord, sewing feet, pedal, etc.
- Hemostats or easy grip pliers (for turning small parts) - turning sticks or chopsticks will also work.
- Embroidery floss (instructor will have some in limited colors)
- Doll needles and hand sewing needles

**Pattern: Debonair Dragon** by Rustic Horseshoe

Please make sure to cut out your pattern pieces and store all of them safely in an envelope or zip bag **before** class. Briefly read over the pattern to familiarize yourself with the pattern and see what variations can be made to the dragon to make it your own!
